Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for July 13, and July 15, 2013, were all clear. Graded stakes tests for July 13, were all clear. Sample #D-9497 on hold by Dalare Associates from July 8, was cleared.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is assisting Dr. Jane Teichner with Graded Stakes testing.

One Jockey and his Valet were selected today for random drug testing. Both tests were negative.

Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #10, “Fishing Creek,” was changed to Daniel Coa. #5, “The Shermanator,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Broad Moon,” was claimed by Robert Gerczak – Carlos Garcia. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 7 - 2.”** **Starters - 11**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH
– “5 - 7 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – THE SWEET AND SASSY STAKES - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m.
OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. Sheldon Russell, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Defy Gravity,”
was changed to Xavier Perez. Jeremy Rose, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Appealing
Stella,” was changed to Alex Cintron. #7, “Irish Exchange,” was scratched as this is a stakes
race. #6, “Appealing Stella,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT START –**
The jockey on the #5, “Defy Gravity,” Xavier Perez, was looking back when the race was
started, which resulted in the horse breaking awkwardly and slowly. We talked to the Starter,
Glenn Menarde, and jockey Perez; who said the horse had gotten her right hind foot on the
pontoon in the gate, just as the starter started the race. The Stewards saw no reason to take
any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. #5, “Yes Papi Yes,”
was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #6, “Shuttered Cat,” was scratched as the
horse was ineligible due to claiming rules (60-day waiting period after a claim), in West
Virginia. **ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 2 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 12**

NINTH RACE – THE DELAWARE HANDICAP (Grade I) - POST TIME – 5:23 p.m.
OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. #4, “Authenticity,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. All
horses for this race were pre-race blood gas tested. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this
race as we were below six betting interest. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 5 - 6.” Starters**
