Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. Luis Garcia, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Clearing,” was changed to Kristina McManigell. #6, “Strong Enough,” was claimed by Patricia Farro – Owner - Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 9**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #1, “Jive Partner,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Coin of the Realm,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 - 9.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Exactanelli,” was changed to Kristina McManigell. #13, “Get the Picture” and #14, “Copla de Oro,” were scratched as alternates. #7, “Exactanelli,” was eased past the finish line. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 10 - 11 - 12.” Starters - 12**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #1a, “Summer Hustler,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Blackburnian” #5, “Summiting” and #6, “Gowden Mile,” were vet scratches. #7, “Zooming White Star” and #8, “Time’s Concern,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Sumo,” was selected for a blood gas test. A claim in for the #11, “World Record,” by owner - trainer Mr. Randy Allen was VOID as the horse that had started here was not entered on the claim blank, therefore the claim blank is incomplete. #9, “Mason’s Hope,” pulled up lame after the race at the seven-eighths pole and was attended by Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. Following her examination, Dr. Teichner reported that “Mason’s Hope” had injured its left front knee. Subsequently, the horse was transported from the racing surface via ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 11 - 3.” Starters - 6**

Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #13, “Trouble in Love,” was changed to Julian Pimentel. #11, “Lucky Lady Lawyer,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #12, “Version,” was scratched by the trainer. #5, “Vielsalm,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 13 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 11**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m. Angel Castillo Jr., the scheduled rider on the #3, “Deployingresources,” was changed to Victor Carrasco. #2, “Ed’s Lion” and #7, “Red Flair,” were vet scratches. Jeremy Rose, the scheduled rider on the #12, “Shanghai Daddy,” was changed to Julian Pimentel. #10, “Parseghian,” was scratched as a main-track only. #12, “Shanghai Daddy,” was scratched as the horse lost a rear shoe and the paddock blacksmith could not get a new shoe on the horse. #8, “I. E. Irish,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Riviera Romper,” was changed to Luis Garcia.
