Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for July 17, 2013 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 8

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Just a Wildflower,” was changed to Alex Cintron, as Mr. Navarro has taken off due to illness. #1a, “Harling’s Darling,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #1a, “Favorite Patriot,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2b, “Blimey,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Crosseyed,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Gangsterontherun,” pulled up lame after the race, and was attended by Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. Following her examination, Dr. Teichner reported that “Gangsterontherun,” had injured its right front knee. Subsequently, the horse was transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 – 1a - 2.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Glorious Notion,” was changed to Victor Carrasco. #1, “Glorious Notion,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. #4, “Classy Citizen” and #6, “Russkiy Lemon,” were vet scratches. #3, “Foundation,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Apalachee Song,” was claimed by Kieron Magee – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. #1, “Copla de Oro” #5, “Confederate Jazz” and #8, “Going Alone,” were vet scratches. Daniel Coa, the rider of the #6, “Luckeyemail,” was unseated when the horse reared up in the post parade. After the incident, Mr. Coa called us, stating that he did not feel comfortable riding the horse. The #6 horse was scratched by the Stewards, as we could not find another jockey willing to ride this horse. #2, “Attention,” pulled up lame after the race, and was attended by Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Following his examination, Dr. Brown reported that “Attention” had injured its left front suspensory. Subsequently, the horse was transported from the racing surface via ambulance. Jockey Jose Vega said he hit his knee on the gate in this race. Mr. Vega called the Stewards, stating that he was going to first aid to be examined. EMT Carisa Lancaster called stating that Mr. Vega signed a refusal of treatment form returning to the jockey’s quarters, and taking off his mount in the eighth race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 11 - 7 - 10.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. Jose Flores, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Dani’s Storm,” was changed to Julian Pimentel. #1, “Who Needs” and #8, “Classy Coco,” were vet scratches. #5, “Almost a Lady,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:57 p.m. Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Kukosa,” was changed to Jevian Toledo. Jose Vega, the scheduled rider on the #11, “So Serene,” was changed to Yamil Rosario. #8, “Agatha K,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Chulula,” was scratched by the trainer. #12, “Bells of Concerto,” was scratched as a main-track only. #7, “Subtle Signal,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 2 - 6 - 10.” Starters - 9**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:28 p.m. Matthew Rispoli, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Snappy,” was changed to Yamil Rosario. Carlos Esquilin, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Jericho Call,” was changed to Jevian Toledo. #1, “Three Bagger,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #8, “Gambit’s Delight,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #8, “Gambits Delight,” requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 8**
