Administrative Hearings:

Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #5, “With Class,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Princess Beau K,” was selected for a blood gas test. A claim in for the #3, “Bressie,” by Mr. Raul Arriagada was **“VOID”** as the claimant lacked sufficient funds in his horsemen’s account. The #3, “Bressie,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 – 1a - 4.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #1a, “A Student,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Thunder Ball,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Avenida Paseo,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 6.”**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. #2, “Back Room Deal,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by the #1, “Truman’s Commander,” ridden Alex Cintron, against the #6, “Sutton Road,” with rider Daniel Centeno. The claim of foul was lodged against the #6, for allegedly coming out in the stretch, causing him to check his horse. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action.
