Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** #6, “Baby Fresh,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Respect the Flag,” was selected for a blood gas test. We experienced a nine minute tote delay in making this race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 4-8 Dead Heat - 3 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m.** #7, “Marie Capri,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 9 - 4.” Starters - 10**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** #9, “Starforaday,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake #4, “Blimey,” was claimed by Charles F. Burnside – Scott Lake. After a three-way shake #5, “Gotta Go Gold,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds, Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #5, “Gotta Go Gold,” requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 2 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 9**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m.** #5, “Tooth N Claw” and #11, “Master of Humor,” were scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.** #1, “Stealing Saratoga,” was scratched by the owner, as the horse would not load on the van. #4, “Cane Garden Bay,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Heather Hollahan. #10, “Yukon Special,” was claimed by Kryskaly Horse Racing, Inc. – Julio Cartagena. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 7 - 4 - 10.” Starters - 9**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m.** #7, “Night Editor,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, “Cee’s My Man” #12, “Harmony Bay” and #13, “I’m Tapped Out,” were scratched as alternates. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH** - Hold and claim of foul by the #3, “Art Class,” with rider Kristina McManigell, against the #2, “Solo Rock,” ridden by Alex Cintron. The claim of foul was lodged against the #2, for allegedly coming in down the stretch, bumping her horse. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 9**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.** Eric Valles, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Mandoob,” was changed to Brian Pedroza. #4, “Mesa Drive,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE** - The #7, “Upside Down,” broke down at the quarter pole. The horse continued to run to the seven-eighths pole before pulling up. “Upside Down” was attended by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown, who placed the horse’s injured left leg in a Kimzey Brace. The injured horse was thereafter removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner, examined the #7 horse in the receiving barn. Following examination of the #7 Dr. Teichner humanely destroyed the horse, due to it sustaining a fractured sesamoid. First aid E.M.T. Mike Cooper called us, stating Mr. Pimentel signed a refusal of treatment form, returning to the jockey’s quarters. After a two-way shake #7, “Upside Down,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:56 p.m.** Julian Pimentel, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Vielsalm,” was changed to Alex Cintron. #11, “Free D’Or” #12, “Christmas Angel” #13, “Secret Signal” and #14, “Purr and Prowl,” were scratched as alternates. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 4 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 10**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:28 p.m.** Eric Valles, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Al Waed,” was changed to Yamil Rosario. #5, “Grate Fire,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 8**
