**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:21 p.m. #3, “Quick Turnover,”** was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 8 - 2.” Starters - 8**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:51 p.m. #1, “All Born Sinners,”** was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Red Jack,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “My Man Dan,” was selected for a blood gas test. #8, “Sure Start,” was claimed by Happy Hour Stable – Paul McClelland. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 7 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:22 p.m.** Frankie Pennington, the scheduled rider on the #6, “He be Somethin,” was changed to Daniel Centeno. #3, “Thinkinquality” #4, “Afleet Bandit” and #9, “All Inclusive,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 6 - 10.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m. #5, “More Glitter,”** was a vet scratch. #8, “Night Editor,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. .

**INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START AND AT THE QUARTER POLE - #9,** “Risen Spirit,” started bucking shortly after the start. The #7, “Baltic Storm,” bolted at the quarter-pole unseating its rider, Vince Halliday, before being caught by the track maintenance crew in the quarter-mile chute. Both horses #7, “Baltic Storm” and #9, “Risen Spirit,” were placed on the Stewards list. First aid E.M.T. Cassy Lancaster called us, stating Mr. Halliday signed a refusal of treatment form, returning to the jockey’s quarters. The Stewards observed jockey Richard Boucher mounted atop the #10, “Final Heat,” hit the horse several times, prior to entering the starting gate. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner called, telling us that the #10 “Final Heat,” had welts on its rump. Photographs were obtained. Jockey Boucher will be reporting to our office to discuss this issue on Monday.
