Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing this morning for Jockey Mr. Richard Boucher for misuse of the whip in the 4th race on Saturday, August 3, 2013. As a result of the hearing, Mr. Boucher was fined the sum of \$250.00 for this violation.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Christian Olmo, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Useful Berry,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #2, “Full Sail Ahead,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Queen Bee Teresa,” was claimed by Anita Racing Stable – Alfredo Velazquez. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH RUN** – The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #1a, “Summer Hustler,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. The #6, “Code Name Noah,” stumbled at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Christian Olmo, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Southern Beach,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #2, “Aim to Win,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Southern Beach,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #8, Southern Beach,” was claimed by D. Scott Peck – Owner - Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:57 p.m. Christian Olmo, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Blinding Ruby,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #2, “Rebelicious” #4, “Market Hall” and #9, “Virginia Rose,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, “Regal Surprise,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Lit’l Edna,” was selected for a blood gas test. We had a seven minute delay as the rider on the #10, Nearly a Notion,” Jose Vega did not feel comfortable riding the horse. The #10, Nearly a Notion,” was sent back to the paddock for a change of riders, from Jose Vega to Martin Solis. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 7 - 10.” Starters - 7**

SAM HARRISON JUVENILE ARABIAN FILLY STAKES (Grade III) - POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. #3, “Bell South,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Royal Richess,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. #6, “Gogo Dancer CS,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6**
