Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, August 6, 2013 for trainer Mr. Donald Roberson for being in possession of syringes, hypodermic needles, unlabeled injectable medications, and labeled injectable medications, on the grounds of Delaware Park. A decision by the Stewards will be forthcoming.

One Jockey and his Valet were selected today for random drug testing. Both tests were negative.
