Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Saturday, May 18, and Monday, May 20, 2013 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #1, “Zany Viola,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #1a, “D.A. Storm,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #7, “Smooth Decision,” was scratched as the horse was ineligible. #6, “Needadrink,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #7, “Fort Macon,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 2 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 9**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #6, “Nellie,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. #4, “Baby Fresh,” was scratched as a main track only. #13, “Imperial Juliet,” was scratched by the trainer. #14, “Spelling Test,” was scratched as an also-eligible. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 11**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #6, “Singing My Way,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m. Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Assateague,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH –** Hold and claim of foul by the #7, “Stormy n’ Sly,” with rider Abel Castellano Jr., against the #5, “Assateague,” with rider Victor Carrasco. The claim of foul was lodged against the #5, for allegedly coming in down the stretch, causing him to check his horse. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. #6, “Grant Park,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 5 - 7.”**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m. Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Political Miss,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Sarasota Empress,” was changed to Ryan Curatolo; no double jocks mount. Oscar Flores, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Italian Nany,” was changed to Matthew Rispoli; no double jocks mount. #4, “Sarasota Empress,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 6 - 4.”** **Starters - 8**
