FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #4, “Biker Chick,” was a trainer scratch. After a three-way shake #6, “Stone of Scone,” was claimed by Four Treasures Farm – Annette Eubanks. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #4, “Is That Blue,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #1, “Golden Wheels,” was a trainer scratch. #4, “Bundestag (GB),” was a vet scratch. #5, “Fly’n Bayou,” was scratched as this race is off the turf. #10, “Cacaway” #11, “Hailstone” #12, “Robscarvic (IRE)” #13, “Upper Afleet” and #14, “Uncle Harry,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Deep Water,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #6, “Cole and Taylor,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m. #3, “Mary’s Mystique” and #5, “Grace Is a Beauty,” were vet scratches. #10, “Dreams of You,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #9, “Very Few Details,” was selected for a blood gas test.

INQUIRY AT THE START – Hold and claim of foul by the rider Alex Cintron, on the #2, “Ruthie Blue Eyes,” against the #1, “Distinctivelady,” and rider Josue Arce, for coming out at the start and bumping his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the

films of the alleged event, it looked like the #1, stumbled at the start, breaking out a little with the #2 breaking out bumping the #4, which pushed the #2 back into the #1. The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **INQUIRY AT THE FIVE EIGHTH'S POLE** – Hold and claim of foul by the rider Josue Arce, on the #1, “Distinctivelady,” against the #11, “Guard the Empire,” and rider Eric Camacho, for coming in at the five eighth’s pole shutting him off. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the alleged event, it looked like the #11, was clear of the #1 when he came over at the five eighth’s pole. The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. **OFF TIME** – 3:51 p.m. #2, “Take It Inside,” was a trainer scratch. #8, “Henin,” was scratched as this race is off the turf. #11, “Version” #12, “She’s My Afleet” #13, “Casually Put” and #14, “Secret Signal,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Edyanne,” was selected for a blood gas test. #9, “Jane’s Heir,” was claimed by Nick Sanna Stables LLC – Michael Pino. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 9 - 1 - 10.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – THE UNBRIDLED BELLE STAKES - POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. **OFF TIME** – 4:23 p.m. #1, “Diva Spirit” #3, “Sheppard’s Pie” #8, “Wardelle” and #9, “Cash for Clunkers,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The starting gate door in the #5 stall opened slightly before the rest of the starting gate doors opened, but the #5 did not break in front of the other horses but with them, getting no advantage over the other horses. The Starter Mr. Glenn Menarde was informed of this occurrence and will examine the starting gate. The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. **OFF TIME** – 4:54 p.m. #1, “Classy Zip,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Lorelei’s Song,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Rockinonthewater” #9, “Magic Mesa” and #10, “Sydney Speaks,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #11, “Too Clever by Half,” was scratched as an alternate. #2, “Making Waves,” was claimed by David A. Ross Racing Stable LLC – Anthony W. Dutrow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. **OFF TIME** – 5:23 p.m. #4, “R B Hess,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 7**
