Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

One Jockey and his Valet were selected today for random drug testing. Both tests were negative.

Administrative Hearings:

On Tuesday, August 20, 2013 Chief State Steward Jack Houghton Jr., met with trainer Mr. Juan Vazquez at the test barn, sending his two split samples for the positive test results of “Stanozolol” to The University of California at Davis Diagnostic Laboratory, an accredited laboratory approved by the DTRC.

On Tuesday, August 20, 2013 we held a hearing for owners Mr. John Patitucci and Mrs. Florence Patitucci for financial irresponsibility, and failure to pay debts when due. Mr. and Mrs. Patitucci failed to appear or call for the scheduled hearing; it was ordered by the Stewards that the amount of the judgment against them be paid in full from their horseman's account. The Court of Common Pleas of the State of Delaware in and for Kent County had issued a judgment, and writ of Fi Fa attachment to the Patitucci account in the amount of the judgment \$33,754.65 which will be issued to Whispering Meadows Equestrian Center.

We had a four minute delay in the start of this race, as the #5, “Wrister,” was sent back to the paddock for an equipment change. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 9 - 5 - 10.” Starters - 9**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #3, “Forgotten Knot,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #1, “Miss Dayna Lee” #2, “Ericafromamerica” #4, “Regal Nurse” and #8, “Miss Pavarotti,” were scratched as main-track only. #13, “Theatricality,” was scratched by the trainer.
ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 9 - 6 - 10.” Starters - 9

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. Victor Carrasco, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Almaz Arjawani,” was changed to Pedro Nazario. #1, “Charming Becky,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Forgetthefantasy,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 10 - 2.” Starters - 10**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. #10, “Ranking Officer” and #11, “Dare Me,” were scratched as alternates. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by the #4, “Senseofentitlement,” with rider Jevian Toledo, against the #3, “Thinkinquality,” with rider Jeremy Rose. The claim of foul was lodged against the #3, for allegedly coming in at the top of the stretch, causing him to steady his horse. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:25 p.m. Victor Carrasco, the scheduled rider on the #13, “She’s a Pistol,” was changed to Xavier Perez. #3, “Icelandic Blast,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Stormy Monse,” was a vet scratch. #11, “Put it on Me,” was scratched by the trainer. #7, “Keypartner,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 13 - 6.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE CAPE HENLOPEN STAKES - POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m. Kristina McManigell, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Penn’s Grant,” was changed to Horacio Karamanos. #1a, “Icabad Crane” and #9, “Manacor (IRE),” were scratched as this is a stake race. #3, “Unbroken,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 8**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:28 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:30 p.m. Victor Carrasco, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Aim High,” was changed to Jevian Toledo. #1, “Adios Vacquero,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “DC Royal Tigre,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 – 1a - 7.” Starters – 8**
