Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for August 15, 2013 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #1, “Unopposed,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Oh What a Day,” broke down in the stretch; the rider Geovany Garcia jumped off after he pulled the horse up. The #6 horse was attended by Dr. Richard Brown, who placed the horse’s injured right leg in a Kimzey Brace. The injured horse was thereafter removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #4, “Berry Girl,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Foxy Syd,” was scratched as an alternate. #5, “Cactusa,” was pulled up after the race, walking off the racing surface. Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters called, stating that the horse had injured its right knee. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 11 - 1.” Starters - 10**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Angel Suarez, the scheduled rider on the #2, “My Boy Jimmy,” was changed to Wesley Ho. It had started raining at ten minutes to post for this race; the main-track is now labeled sloppy. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:32 p.m. We had a 13 minute delay for this race as track maintenance was working on the racing surface. This race was taken off the turf, at two-minutes to post for the fourth race. Angel Suarez, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Parseghian,” was changed to Luis Garcia. #1a, “Yes Papi Yes” and #10, “Tori’s Guy,” were scratched as main-track only. #2, “Upper Afleet” #4, “Fly’n Bayou” #7, “Falconhurst” #9, “Gottalovethedrake” and #12, “Dubai Echo,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. The #8, “Parseghian,” broke through the starting gate prior to the start, was caught immediately by the outriders and returned to the gate to start the race.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:01 p.m. We experienced a thirty-two minute tote delay in making this race official. Daniel Coa, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Carolinaonmymind,” was changed to Luis Garcia. #3, “Just Got In,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Just Got In,” was claimed by Triple Tree Stables – Mary Eppler.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 8 - 4.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. #10, “Rolling Rate” and #11, “Getaway,” were scratched as alternates. #2, “Secret Signal” #3, “She’s My Afleet” and #4, “Miz Topgallant,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 9 - 7.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:15 p.m. #1a “Fair Shake,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Stormin Wendy” and #4, “Respectful Wishes,” were vet scratches. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 6 - 5.”**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:40 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:41 p.m. Luis Garcia the scheduled rider on the #5, “Stormin Lex,” was changed to Pedro Nazario. #1 “Wise Minister,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Stormin Lex,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 8**
