Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Phantasticus,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Coin of the Realm,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #2, “Two Hearts in One” and #5, “Jaggermama,” were scratched as main-track only. #6, “Wicked Jazz,” was scratched by its trainer. #1, “Nikoldini,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #6, “Hiram,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. #1, “Pantera” and #1a, “Imperial Rule,” were trainer scratches. #7, “Curlin’s Kid,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #10, “Russian Humor,” was a vet scratch. #9, “Royal Runner,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m. #4, “Lady Mary” and #5, “Fake Charm,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. After a two-way shake, #3, “Sara’s Angel,” was claimed by Elliott Krems – Scott Lake. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 5**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m.
ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 7**

NINTH RACE – ARABAINS - POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. #2,
“Thistle Dew,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** - The starting gate door for the #5 stall opened slightly before the rest of the starting gate doors opened due to “SECRETS IN LACE” lunging forward prior to the start. We noted that the #5 did not break in front of the other horses but with them, getting no advantage over the other horses. The Starter, Mr. Glenn Menarde called stating that the horse hit the doors of the gate, slightly prior to him starting the race. The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 8 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 9**
