Administrative Hearings:

The following hearings were held on Tuesday, August 27, 2013.

A hearing was scheduled for hot walker Mr. Todd K. Bretz, concerning the matter of disorderly conduct and threatening a trainer in the stable area. Mr. Bretz having failed to appear for the scheduled hearing is suspended pending his appearance.

A hearing was held for jockey Joshua Navarro for speeding through valet parking. Mr. Navarro was fined \$50.00 for this violation, and given a warning that driving privileges would be revoked if this occurred again.

Jockey Manuel Santiago Jr. tested positive this morning for alcohol in the amount of 0.013 on the breathalyzer test. Mr. Santiago was taken off his mount for today, pending his appearance for a hearing.

The races were taken off the turf at 12:10 P.M. due to a heavy rain shower.

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Jonathan Joyce, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Celtic Tigress,” was changed to Jose Caraballo. #1, “Masha” and #7, “Shaikha,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #9, “Auntie Martha,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Quote,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 6 -3.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Xavier Perez, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Tiz Relevant,” was changed to Joshua Navarro. After a two-way shake, #3, “Standing O,” was claimed by Heather Hollahan – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #1a, “Maya Strike,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Echale Salsita,” was scratched by the trainer. #4, “Wendy Wow,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Aunt Ellen,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 5**

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. #1, “Kippers n’ Eggs” and #1a, “Elkhorn Creek” were scratched as main-track only. #2, “Valley Stream,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Coturnix,” was scratched as an alternate. #10, “Rock in Bage (BRZ),” was scratched as this race is off the turf. At approximately 11:25 a.m. #6, “Brahman,” was scratched by the Stewards after we received a call from Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, stating that the horse had an expired coggins confirmed by the van driver Ron Taylor. Subsequently, the horse could not enter the stable area. At approximately 12:10 p.m. we were informed that the horse did have a new coggins test that was faxed to the stall office that the Stewards were not initially aware of. not to the Stewards. With the additional information the horse was allowed to enter the stable area. The #6 was allowed to run for purse money only finishing third. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 8 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 8**
