Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for August 24, and August 26, 2013 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:20 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:51 p.m. #2, “Big Brown Musket,” was claimed by Kelly Lynn Dieter – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. #7, “Zooming White Star,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m. #4, “City Fever,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by the #8, “Clapping,” with rider Eric Camacho, against the #9, “Burn Permit,” with rider Abel Castellano Jr. The claim of foul was lodged against the #9, for allegedly coming out down the stretch, bumping his horse. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. #5, “Boastful Dancer,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. Jonathan Joyce, the scheduled rider on the #9, “Rush Attack,” was changed to Jose Vega. #4, “Captain Easy,” was scratched as a main-track only. #11, “Greeksdevil” #12, “Spookorific” #13, “Harmony Bay” and #14, “Ridley Creek Road,” were scratched as alternates. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 10 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. #2, Clever Dame,” was scratched by the trainer. #1, “Ericafromamerica,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS – THE CRE RUN OAKS ARABIAN STAKES (Grade II) - POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m. Abel Castellano Jr., the scheduled rider on the #8, “Rich Chick,” was changed to Jose Vega. **INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE –** The #9, “Gogo Dancer,” ridden by Eric Valles appeared to clip heels with the #4, “Sugar Sand,” at the quarter pole and fell, causing the riders of the #2, “Chevelle SS,” Tyrone Carter and #3, “Baccarat City,” Brian Pedroza, to be unseated trying to avoid the fallen horse. The #8, “Rich Chick,” pulled up at the top of the stretch after avoiding the fallen horse. The #3, “Baccarat City,” was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. EMT Amy Trowbridge called stating that, all three riders signed a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jockey’s quarters, with Eric Valles going to the hospital on his own for treatment of a cut on his head. The Stewards determined there was no reason to take any action. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 5 - 4.” Starters - 10**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:23 p.m. Eric Valles, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Avvatar,” was changed to Pedro Nazario. #1, “Macc,” was scratched as we could not get a substitute rider for the horse. #8, “Ladys Sandman,” was a vet scratch. #5, “RB Calvin,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 9 - 10.” Starters - 8**
