Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START – Hold and Claim of foul by the #3 “Perstons Princess,” with rider Jose Vega and the #2, “Bogelia,” with rider Victor Carrasco, against the #1, “Hotspur Harriet,” with rider Trevor McCarthy, who broke out sharply impeding the #3, and the #2, at the start. The #1 was disqualified from first and placed third behind the #3 who was moved up to first and the #2 who was moved up to second. Also the #2, “Bogelia,” Victor Carrasco, claimed foul against the #3 “Perstons Princess,” Jose Vega for coming in at the start bumping him. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, in the claim of foul concerning the #2 against the #3. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 9

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #2, “Jet Away,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #5, “Vigilante Law,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #1, “Deployingresources” #1a, “King Touch” #4, “Sachicomula” and #6, “Edson’s Ridge,” were vet scratches. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 4**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. #10, “Pick Four” and #11, Quiet Favorite,” were scratched as main-track only. #12, “Coturnix,” was scratched as an alternate. #8, “Truman’s Commander,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – THE WHIRLING ASH STAKES - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:20 p.m. #1, “Tensas Carlos,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. #1a, “Jessethemarine,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by #1a, “Jessethemarine,” with rider Jose Caraballo, against the #4, “Interchange,” with rider Victor Carrasco, for allegedly coming out bumping him in the stretch. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the #4, came out down the stretch soundly bumping with the #1a, knocking it off stride. Consequently, the #4 was disqualified from first and placed second, behind the #1a, who was moved up to first. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. Matthew Rispoli, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Angel of Mercy,” was changed to Alan Garcia. #4, “Lelanda,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 10 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 12**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:23 p.m. #2, “Miss Paradise,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 1a - 1 - 4.” Starters - 8**
