Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates August 31, and September 2, 2013 were all clear with one exception. Sample #D-8965 retained from the horse, "WHO DAT BOY" which ran in the 5th race on September 2, 2013, tested positive for excessive levels of "Phenylbutazone," in the amount of 8.37 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. Commission Inspectors Swift and Delaney conducted a barn search of trainer Gary R. Katz regarding the positive test. Inspection of the barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer Katz revealed "Phenylbutazone" powder and paste. An interview of subject's veterinarian, Dr. Tim DeLatte was also conducted. Subsequently, trainer Katz appeared before the Stewards, informing us that he would waive his right to a split sample. A hearing will be scheduled for Tuesday, September 17, concerning this matter

Abel Castellano Jr., the scheduled rider on the #5, "Monty's Appeal," was changed to Jose Vega. #1, "Saarface," was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, "Mister Meehan," was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 7 - 6 - 2." Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:51 p.m. Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #8, "Ismael Grande," was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #1, "Battery Backup" and #3, "Managed Account," were scratched as main-track only. #4, "Utley" and #7, "Tune Me In," were scratched by their trainers. #9, "Powder Mountain," was a vet scratch. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – "6 - 8 - 5 - 2." Starters - 4**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:22 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:54 p.m. #1, “My Charming Clyde,” and #3, “Atomic Orange Vet,” were vet scratches. #6, “Conflicting Report,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, Hope Still Springs,” was a late scratch, as he was injured in the starting gate prior to the start. According to Dr. Teichner, “Hope Still Springs” injured its right front leg and right stifle. EMT Amy Trowbridge called stating that the rider of the #4 Brian Pedroza seemed to hurt his left leg, but signed a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jockey’s quarters. We canceled Place, Show, Exacta, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 3**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:24 p.m. #3, “Rugby Road” and #4, “Standing Point,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Alvitude,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 9 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 9**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:56 p.m. #3, “Carpetbagger,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START –** The #2, “Rhythm Blues,” with rider Daniel Centeno, hesitated and then hopped out of the gate, breaking slowly. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action. The #4, “Discreet Reason,” was scratched at two minutes to post by Dr. Teichner for being off in the right front. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE KENT STAKES (Grade III) - POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:27 p.m. #8, “Saint Vigeur,” was scratched as this is a stakes race. All horses for this race were pre-race blood gas tested. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. Chelsey Keiser, the scheduled rider on the #4, “TM Its Just Aride,” was changed to Martin Solis #2, “TA Dance With the Star,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Frynzy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. Chelsey Keiser, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Spin Doctor,” was changed to Daniel Centeno. #7, “Vip,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Aim Hi,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 4 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 7**
