Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing this morning for a 2013 groom applicant's license. During the interview and background checking process, the subject was drug tested and registered a positive for Marijuana. Since the subject was a third-time offender, his license was denied and furthermore, denied participation in Delaware for a period of five (5) years under the authority of DTRC Rule 21.9.4.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. The #3, “Rehab Mo,” with rider Abel Castellano Jr. fell after the race at the seven eights pole, when pulling up. The rider Mr. Castellano was not injured, as he had jumped off the horse. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #3, “Seven Again,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY - SHORTLY AFTER THE FIELD LEAVING THE CHUTE, AND AT THE QUARTER POLE - #2** “Charlie’s Hero,” with rider Vince Halliday, clipped heels with the #1, “Stevia,” shortly after leaving the chute. The rider of the #2 came off the horse after the horse bobbed having clipped heels. At the quarter pole the #1, “Stevia,” with rider Victor Carrasco, clipped heels with the #10, “King of the Faery,” ridden by Sarah Rook. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. The rider of the #2, Mr. Halliday, was examined by E.M.T. Amy Towbridge. The rider signed a refusal of treatment form. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 10**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #4, “Marquetrys Warrior,” lunged at the start, breaking slowly. #4, “Marquetrys Warrior,” pulled up lame after the race, and was transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. The #4, was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown, who reported that the horse was off in the left front. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #5, “Moose Man,” was scratched by the trainer. #2, “Dinny Dinosaur” and #11, “Awesome Mitch,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “Dip My Beak,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 14 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 11

SIXTH RACE – THE GROVER “BUDDY” DELP MEMORIAL STAKES - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #4, “Dreaming of Jazz” and #6, “Michael With Us,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 4

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. #5, “Nobody But You,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Space Race” and #10, “Late Starter,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Fantastic Song,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. #1, “Extra Cool,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6
