The Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission meeting was today at 10:15 a.m.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m.** Jonathan Joyce, the scheduled rider on the #1, “El Tequila,” was changed to Joshua Navarro. #4, “Vanna Go’s Point,” ridden by Julian Pimentel ducked in at the half-mile pole striking the inner rail and was pulled up in the stretch. Jockey Pimentel advised that he did not know what caused the horse to duck in. Mr. Pimentel was not injured as he had stayed on the horse. Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters examined “Vanna Go’s Point” and reported that the horse had cut its shoulder from striking the rail. The horse was thereafter transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters – 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** After a two-way shake #4, “E Street Bourbon,” was claimed by Bill Waldron – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** #7, Whattheravenwants,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m.** #2, “Go Get’m Irish” #4, “Controlled Neglect” and #10, “Prunella de Ville,” were vet scratches. #7, “Deb’s Trip,” was scratched as a main-track only. The saddle had slipped way back on the #9, “El Rey’s Reina,” with rider Yamil Rosario. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m.**  
Kendrick Carmouche, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Unbroken,” was changed to Joshua Navarro. Matthew Rispoli, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Manchurian High,” was changed to Forest Boyce. #3, “Umbraggio,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Wellington Wizard,” was scratched as a main-track only. #6, “Manchurian High,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Unbroken,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds – Jamie Ness. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.** #3, “One Tough Cowgirl,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Shalala,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m.** #3, “Silent Tap,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Jamie’s Valentine,” was scratched as a main-track only. #10, “Fairy Cat,” pulled up lame after the race. Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters reported that the horse was lame in the left front. “Fairy Cat” was thereafter transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 2 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8**

**NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m.** #6, “Night Editor,” was selected for a blood gas test. #9, “Telegraph Hill,” was claimed by William Evins – Jeff Talley. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF STRETCH -** The #2, “R B With Promise,” broke down at the top of the stretch and was pulled up by jockey Alex Cintron. Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters reported that the horse had injured its right front knee and was thereafter transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. We also interviewed jockey Luis Garcia who rode the #3, “Scooby Bayou.” Jockey Garcia related that he eased the his mount before the finish as the horse was not traveling well. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 9**

- *Post Script – On September 19, 2013 Dr. Jane C. Teichner, Commission Veterinarian, and Mr. John Mooney, Delaware Park’s Executive Director of Racing, learned from the trainer, Kelly Deiter, that the ring-bit had broken during the running of the race and that the metal shards impaled the horse’s palate. This is an explanation as to why the rider, Julian Pimentel had no control over the horse that reacted by striking the rail. “VANNA GO’S POINT” has received medical treatment from private practitioner, Dr. Luis Benitez as of this writing 9-19-13. Due to the laceration that “VANNA GO’S POINT” received from the accident, she was placed on the Commission Veterinarian’s Observe List, which is a formality requiring a Commission Veterinarian to witness this horse work-out before it is approved to race again.*
