**Administrative Hearings:**

We held a hearing this morning for Exercise Rider/Jockey Erik Valles concerning his testing positive for alcohol in the amount of 0.324 yesterday and 0.325 this morning prior to his hearing. Mr. Valles was suspended from his duties pending a negative alcohol test and completion of an alcohol abuse program.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1a, “Gunfighter,”** was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. The saddle slipped on the #1, “Favorite Patriot.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #6, “Clever Dancer,”** was a vet scratch. #4, “Talk to Me,” stumbled at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 6**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #1a, “Morales,”** was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. Prior to the start the #1, “Think I’m Hooked,” ridden by Victor Carrasco, broke through the gate, was caught by the outrider and returned to the starting gate. #6, “Hunter Jak,” pulled up shortly after the start. Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown reported that the horse looked fine but as a precaution, was transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Jockey Gabriel Saez, the rider of the #6 reported that his horse had stumbled after taking a bad step and pulled him up.
