Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for September 19, 2013 was all clear with the following exception.

Blood and Urine Sample #D-8950 retained from the horse, "CHINGLISH" which ran in the 4th race on September 19, 2013, tested positive for "nikethamide," and "N-ethylnicotinamide," a metabolite of "nikethamide."

The same sample #D-8950 retained from the horse, "CHINGLISH" which ran in the 4th race on September 19, 2013, also tested positive for excessive levels of "phenylbutazone," in the amount of 4.14 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. Commission Inspector's Swift and Delaney conducted a barn search of trainer Julio Cartagena regarding the positive tests. Inspection of the barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer Cartagena revealed "Phenylbutazone" Boluses. An interview of subject's veterinarian, Dr. Benitez was also conducted. Subsequently, trainer Cartagena appeared before the Stewards, stating that he would waive his right to a split sample for the "Phenylbutazone" positive and accept the fine of \$1,000.00 dollars for a second offense within 365 days according to DTRC rule 15.1.3.1.5. Concerning the "nikethamide," positive for the horse "CHINGLISH" Mr. Cartagena will get back to us tomorrow to let us know which lab he will choose for the split sample, from the list of three approved by the DTRC for the testing of the split sample DTRC rule 15.10.6.10.1.

was a vet scratch. #4, "Awesome Caro," was claimed by Elliot Mavorah – Gregory Sacco.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m. #3, "Forgotten
Knot," was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #2, "Romp City," was
claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds, Inc - Jamie Ness. The new connections of the #2, "Romp
City," requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 3 - 6 - 4."**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #6, “Chinglish,” was scratched by its trainer. A blood sample was drawn from the #6, “Chinglish,” by order of the Stewards. After a two-way shake, #8, “Bluegrass Chat,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #6, “Fran’s Image” and #7, “Rumble Seat,” were vet scratches. #4, “Shalala,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 6**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #4, “Jet Away,” was scratched as a main-track only. #3, “Olympic Medallist,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 7 – 1a - 8.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #3, “Sharp Landing,” was a vet scratch. The #1, “E File,” ducked in sharply at the start. A claim filed for the #1, “E File,” by Home Team Stable & William R. Hill Jr. – Scott Lake, was “VOID” for the lack of sufficient funds in their partnership account for the price of the claim. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 4 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #11, Papa Carlos” and #12, Regimental,” were scratched as alternates. #8, “Saintly Feelings,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #1, “Trading Secrets,” was claimed by Phillip DiCosmo – Robert Dibona. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 10**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. #5, “Lookin’ Foxy,” was claimed by Marian Smith – Kenny Smith. **INQUIRY AT THE SEVEN-EIGHTHS POLE, FIRST TURN** – There was a claim of foul by the rider of the #3, “Apologize,” Alex Cintron, against the #4, “Empress Hatshepsut,” ridden by Matthew Rispoli, for coming in and taking all his room away, causing him to clip heels, losing his right stirrup. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards disqualified the #4, “Empress Hatshepsut,” with rider Matthew Rispoli from first and placed him fifth, behind the #3 who was moved up to fourth. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 6**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:18 p.m. #2, “Ok Nothanksforaskn,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Stonecoldsteamer,” broke though the gate prior to the start was immediately caught by the outrider and returned to the starting gate. #6, “Early Eddie,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vasquez. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 7**
