Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Sample #D-8902 retained from the horse, “Gold on Gold” which ran in the 2nd race on September 23, 2013, tested positive for excessive levels of “phenylbutazone,” in the amount of 2.72 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer Julio Cartagena were not inspected, as the search conducted on 10-2-13 revealed “phenylbutazone” boluses. Mr. Cartagena was informed of this violation telephonically at 10: 50 a.m. on Thursday, October 3, 2013.

Trainer Cartagena will appear before the Stewards, on Saturday, October 5, 2013 concerning the positive lab report for “nikethamide” and “phenylbutazone” overage for the horse “Chinglish,” which ran and finished 3rd in the 4th race on Thursday, September 19, 2013. As for the “phenylbutazone” portion of the “Chinglish” positive, Mr. Cartagena waived his right to a formal hearing.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “Tiz Camera Ready,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Lady Paradime,” stumbled at the start.
ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1, “I’m The Lucky One,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Curlin’s Kid,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Smiling Charlie,” was selected for a blood gas test.
ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 – 1a - 6.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #2, “Nico the Champ,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Sharp Harbour,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #1, “Willijo,” was scratched as a main-track only. #11, “Veruska,” was a vet scratch. Commission Veterinarian, Dr. Teicher, scratched the #6, “Choir Girl” after it flipped in the paddock and injured itself. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH –** The #8, “Confederate Jazz,” ridden by Brian Pedroza came in down the stretch forcing the #9, “Creswell Bay,” with rider Ricardo Chiappe into the temporary rail. The #9 finished in front of the #8, no action by the Stewards was taken and made the race official. #8, Confederate Jazz,” was pulled up after the race and was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Dr. Teichner reported “Confederate Jazz” bowed a tendon in its left front. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 9 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. Ryan Curatolo, the scheduled rider on the #10, “Controlled Neglect,” was changed to Forest Boyce. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH –** Hold and claim of foul by the #10, “Controlled Neglect,” with rider Forest Boyce against the #3, She’s a Pistol,” ridden by Victor Carrasco for coming out down the stretch bothering her horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it appeared like the #10 shied from the #3 in the stretch. Consequently, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 – (5 – 10 DH) - 9.” Starters - 10**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. #1, “Today’s Man,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Quarterback Sneak,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 6

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m. Jorge Vargas Jr., the scheduled rider on the #3, “Stix N Stones,” was changed to Josue Arce. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 8**
