Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, May 22, 2013, were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Carlos Esquilin, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Hammering Buckeye,” was changed to Erasmo Martinez; no double jocks mount. #2, “Access Love,” was scratched by the Stewards as the horse was late for Salix administration, due to a traffic accident backup on interstate 95 north. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 5**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #4, “Baby Fresh” and #6, “Imperial Juliet,” were scratched as main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #7, “Jamie’s Ticket,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Bressie,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. Emilio Flores, the scheduled rider on the #3, “J D’s Firecracker,” was changed to Mathew Rispoli; no double jocks mount. #2, “Dinny Dinosaur,” was scratched as main-track only. After a two-way shake #8, “Space Race,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed #8, “Space Race,” requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. #6, “Late Starter,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. Jose Caraballo, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Ghost of Sage Cat,” was changed to Rosario Montanez; no double jocks mount. #10, “Mine Only Mine,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Runway Flair” and #11, “Our Lucky Lady,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “City at Dawn,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. INQUIRY AT START - Jockey Victor Carrasco, the rider of the #4, “Regal Revenge,” hit his right leg on the side of the gate at the start, losing his stirrup. Shortly after the start the rider took his other foot out of stirrup, just sitting on the horse finishing the race. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. Emilio Flores, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Sharp Defrere,” was changed to Mathew Rispoli; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Chin’n Tonic (IRE),” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Who Dat Boy” and #10, “Shamroge,” were scratched as main-track only. #8, “Century Gold,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY IN STRETCH –** The #3, Sharp Defrere,” ducked to the inside at the gap hitting the temporary rail, unseating its rider, Matthew Rispoli. The horse and the rider both got up immediately. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. The rider of the #3 Mr. Rispoli, was examined by E.M.T. Mike Cooper, signing a refusal of treatment form. The #3, was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported that the horse had mild abrasions from the fall in the stretch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 9**
