Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for September 25, and September 26, 2013 were all clear.

**Administrative:**

Trainer Julio Cartagena contacted the Stewards and opted to have the split sample sent to referee laboratory, University of California at Davis, to confirm the presence of Nikethamide that was discovered in the post race sample from “CHINGLISH” who finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the 4<sup>th</sup> race on September 19, 2013.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:20 p.m.** #1a, “Judymoon,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Where’s Alayna” #4, “Marie Capri” and #5, “Winning Player,” were vet scratches. #7, “Duck Duck Goose,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interest. #6, “Tower Ravens,” was claimed by Inwood Farm – Lloyd Palmer.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 4**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:51 p.m.** #5, “Rehab Mo,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Money Drive,” with rider Pedro Nazario, stumbled at the start, with the rider losing his stirrups. **INQUIRY AT THE START** - The #7, “Simba Bahari,” lunged prior to the start breaking open the starting gate doors, but did not get any advantage. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner reported that the #6, King Touch had come back sore and requested the horse ambulance transport the horse back to the barn. The Trainer of the #6, Juan Vazquez refused to load the horse on the ambulance and walked the horse back to the test barn. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 3 - 7.” Starters – 6** *Note: Trainer Vazquez will be summoned to appear before the Stewards regarding this matter.*

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:21 p.m.** #1, “Tickled Blue” #4, “Tony B” and #7, “Flying Joe,” were vet scratches. #3, “Miguez,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below five betting interest. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 4**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m.**  
**INQUIRY DEEP STRETCH** - The #4, “Paskha,” broke down in deep stretch, unseating the rider, Alex Cintron. The #4, “Paskha,” was attended by Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown, who humanely destroyed the horse due to it sustaining a fractured cannon bone. First aid E.M.T. Amy Trowbridge reported that Jockey Cintron signed a refusal of treatment form, returned to the jockey’s quarters and excused himself from the remainder of his mounts on the card. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m.** Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Baked Alaska,” was changed to Angel Suarez. #5, “Hope On the Rocks,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE FIVE SIXTEENTH POLE** - #7, “Scennie Nation,” unseated its rider, Brian Pedroza after it drifted out at the five-sixteenths pole. First aid E.M.T. Amy Trowbridge reported that Jockey Pedroza signed a refusal of treatment form, returned to the jockey’s quarters and opted to take off the remainder of his mount for the day. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – THE POLLYS JET STAKES - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m.** Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Pearl Turn,” was changed to Joshua Navarro. #8, “Hedonemewrongsong,” was scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #6, “Diva Spirit,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m.** Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Take the Offer,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Solo Rock,” was changed to Joshua Navarro. Brian Pedroza, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Marq Your Bible,” was changed to Carlos Esquilin. #2, “Italian Monarch,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 8 - 6 - 9.” Starters - 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS – THE BUZZ BRAUNIGER ARABIAN DISTAFF HANDICAP (Grade I) - POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m.** Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Frynzy,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**
