Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for October 2, and October 3, 2013 were all clear.

Administrative:

Dr. Kathleen Picciano is substituting for Dr. Richard Brown.

A hearing was conducted on Tuesday, October 8, 2013 for trainer Julio Cartagena regarding his positive test for “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 2.72 micrograms per milliliter of plasma, from the horse “Gold on Gold” who won the 2nd race on September 23, 2013. Mr. Cartagena waived his right to a split sample, and due to this being his third offense of DTRC Rule 15.1.3.1.5, will be suspended the first seven calendar days at the start of the 2014 racing season, and fined the sum of \$1,000.00.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Rowdy Rita,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. #1, “Shuku,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Sister Chant,” was a vet scratch. #5, “The Bean Sisters,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 – 2b – 6 – 1a.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:54 p.m. #1, “Gimme Jimmy,” was scratched by the trainer. #7, “Pepper Bay,” was a vet scratch. The #6, “Harlington Romance,” was a late scratch, as she had unseated jockey Jose Caraballo during the post parade and ran off. While the horse was loose, it ran into the railing and sustained a shoulder injury according to Commission Veterinarian, J. Teichner, and was subsequently scratched. First aid E M T Bob Biggs reported that Jockey Caraballo was examined at first aid, signed a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jock’s room. Jockey Caraballo excused himself from his remaining mount on the card. We had a delay of nine minutes to the start of this race, waiting for A-3 to return from transporting Mr. Caraballo to first aid. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 5**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #1, “Heart of Nepal” and #6, “Forgotten Knot,” were scratched as main-track only. #9, “Manacor (IRE),” was scratched by the trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 8 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – THE BARBARO STAKES - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. Angel Serpa, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Keep the Canoli,” was changed to Kendrick Carmouche. #1, “Street Shark,” was scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #3, “Purple Egg,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. Jonathan Zayas, the scheduled rider on the #5, “E Biscuit,” was changed to Shannon Uske. #4, “Secret Jackpot” #7, “Rugby Road” and #13, “Who Dat Boy,” were scratched as main-track only. #2, “Tubby Time,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds, Inc - Jamie Ness. The new connections of the #2, “Tubby Time,” requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 12 - 6.” Starters - 10**
