Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Saturday, May 25, and Monday, May 27, 2013, were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Jose Caraballo, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Sarava’s Diva,” was changed to Luis Garcia; no double jocks mount. #1, “Sarava’s Diva,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed #1, “Sarava’s Diva,” requested a \$175.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 8**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.
ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #5, “Star Destiny,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #5, “Star Destiny,” with rider Jose Caraballo, stumbled shortly after the start, causing the rider to loose his stirrups. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 7 - 2.” - Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #1a, “Costa De Oro,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Springfield Alley,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #5, “Court’s Journey,” was claimed by Danny Limongelli - Hugh McMahon. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 5**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #2, “Marie’s Babe,” was scratched by the Stewards, as the trainer is under suspension in New York. #5, “Dangerous Behavior,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Ericafromamerica” and #8, “Fragancia,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Tinderbox,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START - #1,** “Charmingmegan,” broke through the starting gate prematurely, being briefly restrained by the assistant starter. Since the #1, “Charmingmegan,” was precluded from a fair start, we considered it a non-starter for all wagering purposes. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 9 - 10.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – THE JOSEPH FRENCH MEMORIALSTAKES - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:20 p.m. #1, “Private Tail” #1a, “Jimanator” and #8, “Thunder Lord,” were scratched as this is a stakes race. #3, “Lubango,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 9 - 3.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m. #1, “El Pichon,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Who Dat Boy,” was scratched as main-track only. #7, “Written Word,” was scratched to re-enter by the racing office. #8, “R. B. Float,” was a vet scratch. #6, “True Test,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 10 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 7**
