Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

We received workout test results from LGC Sports Science LLC, Lexington, for Thursday, May 8, 2014 which were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #4, “Tawhiri,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #5, “Standup Paddle,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Luis Belmonte, the rider on the #4, “Cee’s My Man,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. Julio Hernandez, the rider on the #5, “Proud Tiger,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #7, “A.P. Wild,” was claimed by South View Stables – Michael Pino. #7, “A.P. Wild,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #2, “Access Love,” and #8, “Hello Prince,” were vet scratches. After a three-way shake, #3, “Winning Touch,” was claimed by Kazdan Racing Stables – Alejandro Maymo. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #1a, “Ball and Chain,” and #2b, “Wild Kay,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #5, “Course I’ll Wynn,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Wild Oration,” was claimed by Kazdan Racing Stables – Alejandro Maymo. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START – #3, “General Ike,” raced with no whip. The #1, “Black Ice,” broke in at the start unseating its rider, Alex Freites. The #8, “Cosa Dolce,” stumbled at the start unseating its rider, Forest Boyce. Both loose horses were caught by the outriders. The #1 who was running last was caught at the half-mile pole, and the #8 was caught after the race pulling up. The riders Alex Freites and Forest Boyce were examined by EMT Mike Cooper, who called the Stewards reporting that the riders were examined and uninjured. Both riders signed a refusal of treatment form before returning to the jockey’s quarters. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters – 8.**

Both horses were examined by Drs. Peters and Brown following the race and were determined to be uninjured. Dr. Peters also followed up on the morning of 5-22-14 to re-inspect both horses. SEVENTH RACE – THE WINTER MELODY STAKES - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. We approved a weight correction upon request of the racing office, for the #5, “Blue Violet,” from 122 lbs. to 120 lbs. due to race win conditions. #2, “Emerald Bracelet,” and #6, “Villette,” were scratched in compliance with Stakes Race Provision Rule 11.14.1.1. #8, “Made Up,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 4 - 8.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. Carol Cedeno, the rider on the #1, “RB Djustify,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; double jocks mount will be charged. #1a, “Madjanthis,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Quick and Rich,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7**
