Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

We received workout test results from LGC Sports Science, Lexington, for Thursday, May 14, 2014 which were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. A claim submitted for the #6, “Fond of Candy,” by Owner –Trainer Mark Powell, was “**VOID**” as the spelling of the horse’s name that the owner had started here was incorrect. Mr. Powell had spelled the horse’s name BR Dance Red the correct spelling is BR Dancin Red. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters – 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #3, “Four Star Princess,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #8, “Bluebrass Belle,” was claimed by Gumpster Stable LLC – Michael Gorham. #7, “Youcancountonme,” ridden by Fray Martinez, was eased at the seven-eights pole after the race. The #7, “Youcancountonme,” was examined by Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who said the horse was off in the left front, sustaining a bowed tendon. The horse ambulance was requested to assist and transport the horse back to its stall. The #8, “Bluebrass Belle,” pulled up and was unsaddled at the seven-eights pole after the race. The saddle had slipped off to the side with the rider Ashley Broussard getting off. Both riders that had dismounted their horses were uninjured. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. Travis Dunkelberger, the scheduled rider on the #11, “Principessa Gina,” was changed to Jose Caraballo; no double jocks mount. #4, “Lethal Lil Lady,” and #9, “Tiara Gold,” were vet scratches. #8, “Fall Colors,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 10 - 6.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #9, “Six Ring Sign,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The rider of the #5, “Our Luck Lady,” Jevian Toledo, put the race on hold stating that his horse was impeded shortly after the start. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #3 broke outward and the #7 broke inward at the start. Since the #5 finished in front of both horses, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 12 - 4.” Starters - 11**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #2, “Social Statement,” and #9, “Before You Know It,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Arden Natalie” was a vet scratch. #12, “Silver Arch,” was scratched by the trainer. #3, “Passing Pfast,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. Robert Paz, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Bake Shop,” was changed to Brian Pedroza; double jocks mount will be charged. #8, “Warrioroftheroses,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Stormin Monarcho,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 9 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 9**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. #4, “Rictik,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 6**
