Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

We issued a ruling today, fining Trainer David Jacobson \$500.00 for an unauthorized equipment change on the horse “Stormin Monarcho,” who ran in the seventh race on Saturday, May 24, 2013 with “blinkers on.”

We tested one jockey today, who tested positive for a controlled medication without a valid prescription. The jockey was removed from his mount for today. A Stewards hearing will be scheduled for this violation.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18 p.m. #2, “Make Me a Deal,” was claimed by Mark Powell – Owner-Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 5.”**
Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 7 - 4.” **Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #2, “Superstructure,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Grand Mast,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #1, “Dreaming of Jazz,” was claimed by John Fanelli & King Star – Juan Vazquez. The Owner and Trainer that claimed the #1 requested a \$145.00 all inclusive special test. #3, “The Hidden Ace,” was claimed by Mark Powell – Owner-Trainer. #5, “Hitec Dave,” was claimed by Raul Arriagada – Heather Hollahan. Daniel Centeno the rider of the #5, Hitec Dave,” was unseated while pulling up. The Jockey was questioned by the EMT Nancy who informed the Stewards that the Jockey was OK to continue riding. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 1 - 3.”**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #3, “Blue Shiner,” was scratched as a main-track only. #7, “Ca Va,” was scratched by its trainer. #11, “Tara by the Bay,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Little Miss Brown,” was selected for a blood gas test. Hold and claim of foul by Ricardo Chiappe the rider of the #2, “Cherokee Kitten,” against rider Jevian Toledo of the #8, “Little Miss Brown,” shortly after the start, for coming in causing him to check his horse. After reviewing the films of the race it looked as though the #8 was clear of the #2 while coming inward. No inquiry was called in the running of this race. The Stewards saw no reason for a disqualification and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 9**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #7, “R.A. Superstar,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Southern Christmas,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START AND STRETCH** - Jose Caraballo the rider of the #2, Boom Boom Frankie,” claimed foul against Fray Martinez the rider of the #5, “Ours is a Double,” for coming out twice in the stretch, causing his horse to shy out. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the #5 was disqualified from first and placed second, behind the #2 who had finished second and was moved up to first. #4, “Southern Christmas,” dwelt at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. #1, “Withhighonors,” and #5, “Double Prophecy,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #2, “Big Momma,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 – 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m. Abel Mariano, the scheduled rider on the #12, “Asiknowit,” was changed to Jose Vega; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Rum Tum Tugger,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Blown Save,” #8, “Lucky Inspiration,” and #10, “Forest Jingles,” were scratched as main-track only. #9, “Dear John,” was scratched by the racing office. #12, “Asiknowit,” with rider Jose Vega bolted at the top of the stretch, moving outward past the middle of the racetrack. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 11 - 7.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. #8, “Penny’s Chime,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Edyanne,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Edyanne,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. The #7, “Deb’s Trip,” broke slowly, which she has done in the past. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 7**
