Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

We issued a trainer's test on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 to Owner, Silvio L. Martin. Mr. Martin has passed the written examination, and will be issued a certificate of completion.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Pedro Nazario, the scheduled rider on the #7, "Wokeuponhomeplate," was changed to Brian Pedroza; no double jocks mount. #4, "Eight Riders," was selected for a blood gas test. #6, "Trumpeter Swan," was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 1 - 7 - 4." Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. #1, "Westye's Dream," was scratched by its trainer. #14, "Gitano Boy," was scratched as an alternate. #3, "Another Surprise," was claimed by Tim Richey Racing Stable Inc – Tim Richey. **INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN –** The #6, "Master Zeus," ducked in during the stretch run, going through the inside rail for no apparent reason, unseating its rider Fray Martinez. Jockey Martinez was transported to hospital for evaluation. Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner examined the #6, "Master Zeus," stating that the horse had a laceration on its right hind quarter. At the request of Dr. Teichner, the horse ambulance transported the injured equine back to its barn. The Stewards determined there was no reason to make any changes to the order of finish and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 4 - 2 - 13." Starters - 12**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:22 p.m. Pedro Nazario, the scheduled rider on the #3, "African Jewel," was changed to Mohamed Ozman; no double jocks mount. #1, "Rock on Thelma," was scratched by the Stewards, as the foal papers were not on file with the horse identifier. #4, "Four Star Princess," was scratched by its trainer, as the blacksmith could not get shoes on the horse. #2, "Erzulie Dantor," was selected for a blood gas test. #5, "Poppy's Double," was a vet scratch. Prior to the race, the #2, "Erzulie Dantor," flipped in the starting gate and injured its left hock and was consequently scratched by Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place

and Show wagering for this race, as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 3**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m. #7, “Won the War,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 – 1a - 3 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. Pedro Nazario, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Lake Nona,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #4, “Casual Creeper (IRE),” was scratched by its trainer. **INQUIRY IN THE FIRST TURN** – Forest Boyce, the rider of the #9, “Midnight Fun,” was unseated from her mount going into the first turn. Videos of the incident were inconclusive. The Stewards saw no reason to make any changes, making the race official. The rider Forest Boyce was examined by EMT Tyler Bailey, who called the Stewards reporting that the rider was examined and uninjured. The rider signed a refusal of treatment form before returning to the jockey’s quarters. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 10 - 5 - 11.” Starters - 11**

SIXTH RACE – THE GROVER “BUDDY” DELP MEMORIAL STAKES - POST TIME – 3:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:54 p.m. #4, “Allstar,” was scratched in compliance with stakes provision rule 11.14.1.1 #6, “Classic Giacnroll,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. #6, “He Can Run,” was scratched by its trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 9**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIAN - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. Brian Pedroza, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Miss Paradise,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 6**
