Administrative:

We issued the following rulings on Tuesday, June 2, 2014

Exercise rider Amanda Dobbs was fined the sum of \$100.00 for working in the stable area without a Commission license.

We reinstated Apprentice Jockey, Carlos Gutierrez after he satisfied the financial requirements in Stewards ruling 03-2014.

We issued a ruling fining Trainer Jay Armstrong \$500.00, for failure to have the foal papers on file in the racing office for the horse, "Forever Smile" on Saturday, May 31, 2014, necessitating a late scratch.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Fray Martinez the scheduled rider on the #7, "Social Statement," was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #2, "Alpha Darlin," was a vet scratch. #7, "Social Statement," was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – "7 - 3 - 1 - 6." Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #3, "Mide as Well," was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – "6 - 2 - 3 - 4." Starters - 8**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #1, "My True Lady," was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #7, "Briar Mojo," was selected for a blood gas test. #5, "Patriots Dream," was eased and pulled up at the eighth pole. #5, "Patriots Dream," was examined by Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who informed the Stewards that the horse had run down. Brown requested the horse ambulance to return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #1, “Lets Get Going,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #2, “Margin,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #6, “Cool Under Fire,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Small Town Talk,” was scratched as a main-track only. #4, “Tappinintovictory,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. Fray Martinez the scheduled rider on the #5, “Yano,” was changed to Horacio Karamanos; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – THE OUR MIMS STAKES - POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #5, “Tupancy Links,” was changed to Christian Reyes; no double jocks mount. #2, “Southwest Lady,” #4, “Charlie Renee,” #7, “Our Epiphany,” and #11, “Spunderful,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 9 - 5.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:57 p.m. Victor Carrasco the scheduled rider on the #1, “Market Line,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. Nik Juarez the scheduled rider on the #9, “Patriotic Win,” was changed to Horacio Karamanos; no double jocks mount. #3, “Miss Al Capote,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Maria’s Song,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vasquez. The owner and trainer that claimed the #7, “Maria’s Song,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test. #1, “Market Line,” was scratched by the Stewards after unseating its rider, Javier Santiago in the post parade, and then running off. Javier Santiago the rider of the #1 walked to the ambulance and was examined by the EMT’s and determined to be uninjured. He subsequently returned to the jockey’s quarters. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 8**
