Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Saturday, May 17, and Wednesday, May 21, 2014 were all clear, with the following exceptions. ” For Saturday, May 17, 2014 sample #40450 for the 2nd race winner, “Crimson Pride” trainer Randy Nunley, is on hold, awaiting a certificate of analysis. For Wednesday, May 21, 2014 sample #40459 for the 2nd race winner, “A. P. Wild” trainer Juan Vasquez, and sample #40461 for the 4th race winner “Winning Touch” trainer Jamie Ness, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis. Two workout sample test results for May, 22, 2014 were returned. Sample #4029 for trainer Joann Alek was clear, but sample #40258 for trainer McLean Robertson is on hold. We are awaiting a certificate of analysis for Mr. Robertson’s test. The horse will remain on the veterinarian’s list, until the certificate of analysis is presented.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:19 p.m. Daniel Centeno the scheduled rider on the #4, “Big Brown Musket,” was changed to Mohamed Osman; no double jocks mount. #1, “Very Potent,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:51 p.m. Andre Ramgeet the scheduled rider on the #6, “Miz Marzy,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. Claim of foul by Anthony Pecoraro, the trainer of the #3, “Heated Exchange,” against the #4, “Ephyra,” for coming in bothering his horse in the stretch run. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined the #4 did not alter course, but the #8, “Lake Michigan,” came out when clear of the #3. No inquiry or rider claim of foul was lodged in this race. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 10**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:28 p.m. Gilberto Santiago the scheduled rider on the #1, “Divine Intention,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #2, “Raven’s Chip,” flipped in the starting gate and was thereafter examined by Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Dr. Brown recommended that the horse be scratched due to injuring itself in the gate. The rider of the #2 Jevian Toledo was not injured after being unseated and walked to the ambulance. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:58 p.m. #5, “Stormin Coneja,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:28 p.m. #3, “Mummi’s Hope,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 9**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:56 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:57 p.m. Joshua Navarro the scheduled rider on the #3, “Love This Kitty,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #1, “Sydney Speaks,” and #13, “Lively Times,” were vet scratches. #8, “Antietam Creek,” and #9, “Course I’ll Wynn,” were scratched as main-track only. #3, “Love This Kitty,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE EIGHTH POLE –** Hold and claim of foul by Daniel Centeno the rider of the #5, “Flo’s Strawberry,” against Jevian Toledo, the rider of the #3, “Love This Kitty,” for coming out and bumping him at the eighth pole. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards disqualified the #3 from fourth and placed him fifth, behind the #5 who was moved up to fourth. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 10 - 11 - 5.” Starters - 9**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:32 p.m. Joshua Navarro the scheduled rider on the #4, “Cash Crop,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #6, “Greek God,” and #7, “Snuggly Bear,” were vet scratches. #1, “Nest of Pirates,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 1 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS – THE ARABIAN DIAMOND STATE STAKES Grade II - POST TIME – 5:02 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:03 p.m. Jevian Toledo the scheduled rider on the #1, “RB Champagne Taste,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. Juan Torres the scheduled rider on the #8, “Quick and Rich,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Madjanthis,” #2b, “Burning Fleet,” #6, “Grate Fire,” and #10, “RB Djustify,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 7**
