Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Brian Pedroza the scheduled rider on the #4, “Wokeuponhomeplate,” was changed to Horacio Karamanos; double jocks mount will be charged. Hold and Claim of foul by Horacio Karamanos, the rider of the #4, “Wokeuponhomeplate,” against rider Daniel Centeno on the #2, “Senor Quickie,” for coming out bumping him twice in the stretch. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. No Stewards Inquiry was called in this matter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - INTERNATIONAL LADIES FEGENTRI - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. Annie Yeager the scheduled rider on the #2, “Gitano Boy,” was changed to Ellidh Grant; no double jocks mount. Tias Lyapustina the scheduled rider on the #8, “Mr. Fahrenheit,” was changed to Anna Carrow; no double jocks mount. #1, “Cherokee Creek,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Brother Mark,” was claimed by The Elkstone Group LLC – Thomas Iannotti IV. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 3 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 9**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. #1, “Full of Intent,” was claimed by Texas Toyco LLC – Jeff Talley. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – Hold and claim of foul by Alex Cintron the rider of #2, Penny’s Chime,” against the rider of the #3, “Gitanilla,” Jomar Ortega, for coming in, and the #1, “Full of Intent,” with rider Victor Carrasco, for coming out causing him to check his mount. After reviewing the films and talking with the riders involved it looked like the #2 broke a step slow with the #1 and #3 filling the void left by the #2. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. #4, “Score Boyera,” pulled up lame after the race at the seven-eight’s pole. The #4 was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters who informed the Stewards the #4 had pulled a right front suspensory. Dr. Peters requested the horse ambulance transport the horse back to its stall. The rider Carol Cedeno had dismounted from the horse and was not injured. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 1 - 3.” Starters – 7**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m.
#9, “King Crab,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Dominate,” was selected for a blood gas test.

INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN – The #3, “Chelsea Pier,” with rider Brian Pedroza ran through the inside rail at the top of the stretch for no apparent reason. The #3 horse was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters who informed the Stewards that the #3 had a laceration on the left front elbow. Dr. Peters requested the horse ambulance to transport the horse back to its stall. Jockey Brian Pedroza, who was unseated, walked to the ambulance and was transported to first aid to be examined. EMT Amy Trowbridge called the Stewards stating the jockey Brian Pedroza was ok, signing a refusal of treatment form.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 12

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. #3, “Sir Celtic Express,” #5, “Tracy’s Turn,” and #7, “Blue Coast,” were vet scratches. #6, “Tarifa,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show, wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 4**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. Alex Cintron the scheduled rider on the #6, “Artic Bird,” was changed to Jose Vega; no double jocks mount. #3, “Let’s Make a Zeal,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Clowns to the Left,” was claimed by South View Stables – Michael Pino. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m.
This race was taken off the turf, just after the fifth race. The jockeys were concerned that the turf course was slippery. #11, “Nickyrocksforpops,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Sabouli,” #3, “Dance Craze,” #5, “Trouble in Love #7, “D’ Orsay and #8, “It’s my Time (GB),” were scratched as this race is off the turf. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. #1, “Miss Paradise,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 5**
