The Stewards attended the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission meeting today, at 10:15 a.m.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Carol Ceden the scheduled rider on the #7, “Frogtown,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #6, “Decorated Admiral,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, “Exclusively Greek,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Quinby Pete,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #7, “Quinby Pete,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test. **INQUIRY AT THE START - #2, “Run to the Limit,”** stumbled at the start, unseating rider, Daniel Centeno. It was later reported by EMT Patrick Gilcrest that Mr. Centeno did not sustain any injury as a result of the incident. Mr. Centeno signed a refusal of treatment form returning to the jockey’s quarters. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. Daniel Centeno the scheduled rider on the #1, “Moon Map,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. Carol Ceden the scheduled rider on the #7, “Chispi Affair,” was changed to Angel Serpa; no double jocks mount. #4, “Mary’s Mystique,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #3, “Tiniebla,” and #6, “Ha Ha Fooled Ya,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #4, “Sarasota Empress,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 5**

We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place, and Show, wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 9 - 8.” Starters - 3**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #5, “It’s a Bang,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Shimmy Tinjo,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 6**

SEVENTH RACE – THE DASHING BEAUTY STAKES - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. Abel Lezcano the scheduled rider on the #3, “Galiana,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #5, “Five Star Momma,” and #7, “Saturday Nthe Park,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 9 - 11 - 10.” Starters - 9**
