Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Wednesday, May 28, 2014 were all clear, with the following exceptions: Samples #40488 and #40495 are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

We tested a jockey today, who tested positive for Amphetamines and Opiates. The test for opiates had cleared from the test very quickly, before the jockey was scheduled and allowed to ride. The jockey produced a doctor's prescription for the diet amphetamines, and the "hydrodon acetaminophen (Vicodin)." *The DTRC Executive Director met with the Board of Stewards regarding this matter on the morning of 6-16-14. This matter is under review.*

Associate Commission Veterinarian John Whiston is substituting for Dr. Richard Brown today. Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is performing mandatory sample collection for the Grade III, OBEAH STAKES.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. After a two-way shake, #6, "Gold Diggin Dixie," was claimed by No Guts No Glory Stable – Gina Rosenthal. #2, "Salsamon," broke slowly. **ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 1 - 4 - 6." Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. Chris Baker, the scheduled rider on the #1, "Scarlet O'Cashy," was changed to Kaylia Albright; no double jocks mount. #1a, "Dopke Gal," was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, "Quincy Lee," and #6, "Dancing Sparks," were scratched as this race is off the turf. #7, "Political Miss," and #11, "Glore Racer," were vet scratches. #3, "Jill's Image," was selected for a blood gas test. The distance for this race of about one mile on the turf, was changed to one mile on the main track. **ORDER OF FINISH – "10 - 8 - 4 - 3." Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #2, “Charli Sunshine,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as were below six betting interests. #4, “Include the Cat,” was claimed by Exacta BS LLC – Juan Vazquez. #6, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 3 - 6.”**

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #1, “Queenofzeenile,” was scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #8, “Don’tstop Theparty,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, “Archer Queen,” #12, “Sweet Soliloquy,” and #13, “Set On Salsa,” were scratched as alternates. The originally scheduled distance for this race of about 7 ½ furlongs on the grass was changed to 1 mile on the main track. #3, “Rich Chocolate,” dwelt at the start. #7, “Catangelic,” stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #1, “Dixie Deputy,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Hung Jury,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Isolation Road,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2b - 9 - 3 - 5.”**

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #1a, “Scotty Tempo,” and #2b, “Mighty Grand,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #2, “Tutuola,” #3, “Hochman,” and #10, “Colmont Kid,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #12, “Dream Defence,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Trace Screen,” was selected for a blood gas test. Jockey, Jose Vega eased the #8, “Dynaforest Destiny,” in the stretch. Jockey Vega stated the horse was not traveling well. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 9 - 11 - 6.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – THE OBEAH STAKES Grade III - POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. In compliance with the graded stakes race committee requirements, all horses for this race were pre-race blood gas tested. Victor Carrasco the rider on the #1, “Golden Productions,” requested the race be placed on hold, wanting the Stewards to look at the run approaching the three-eighths pole. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 3 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m. #7, “Hughes Next,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Hyarima,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 8**
