Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano is substituting for Dr. Richard Brown.

We held a hearing for Jockey, Abel Mariano, concerning his positive test result for BZO (Benzodiazepine) without a valid prescription. For a second positive drug offense Mr. Mariano was suspended for a period of six months, from Monday, May 26, 2014 through and including Wednesday, November 26, 2014. Mr. Mariano shall also continue in his current drug and alcohol counseling program. *The Stewards ruling was in accordance with the provisions of Rule 21.9*

We tested one jockey today, who has tested negative.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #3, “Smooth Approach,” was a trainer scratch. #1 “Lady Marian Louise,” stumbled at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #7, “Surge Ahead,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #4, “Mo Work for Tim,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Sweet Yulianna,” was selected for a blood gas test. Hold and claim of foul by Deirdre Panas the rider of the #1, “Thedamageisdone,” against Joshua Navarro the rider of the #6, “She Be Bunny,” for coming in at the 5 ½ furlong pole making her check her horse. No Inquiry was called in this race. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. The #3, “Tracey’s Smile,” broke down after being pulled up at the 5/16 pole. The #3 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who placed its injured left front leg in a Kimzey brace and thereafter had it transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance.

(Third Race Continued) The rider, Jomar Ortega was apparently uninjured and held “TRACEY’S SMILE” until the arrival of the outrider. We later were told by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters that the injured horse had suffered a broken sesamoid in the left front leg. “TRACEY’S SMILE” was humanely destroyed by private practitioner, Dr. Donald Johnson. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 7.” Starters – 6**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #2, “Forward Momentum,” was scratched by the trainer. #4, “Salsalito,” and #9, “Thorin,” were vet scratches. #11, “Dreamin of Bucks,” was scratched as a main-track only. #13, “Pirradazis,” was scratched as an alternate. #1, “Another Surprise,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Daddy in the Dark,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 3 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. After a two-way shake, #1, “Pushin ‘On,” was claimed by Top Notch Racing – Michael Pino. #3, “Money in Action,” pulled up lame after the race at the 6 1/2 furlong pole. The #3 was examined by Dr. Teichner, who had the horse removed via horse ambulance. Jockey, Pablo Fragoso, who rode the #3, was uninjured after dismounting the horse and holding it until the arrival of the outrider. Dr. Teichner reported that “Money in Action,” had sustained a fracture of its left front leg. Subsequently, the horse was humanely destroyed by private practitioner, Dr. Lydia Hamilton. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 – 6 Dead Heat - 2 – 4 - 9.” Starters - 10**

SEVENTH RACE – THE HOCKESSIN STAKES - POST TIME – 4:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:20 p.m. Yomar Ortiz the scheduled rider on the #1, “Major Kling (KOR),” was changed to Xavier Perez; no double jocks mount. #5, “Service for Ten,” #6, “Bandbox,” #9, “Won the War,” #11, “Evolution Rocks,” and #12, “Broad Rule,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #10, “Action Andy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:49 p.m. #6, “Dancing Misty,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2 “Se Deci,” was sent for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 6**
