FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Vander Gelder,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 7**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #3, “Poppa’s Pick,” was scratched by the Stewards, as the horse was late for Salix treatment time. #1, “Yano,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #1a, “Star Zapper,” and #9, “Billy One Lite,” were vet scratches. #8, “Tequila Rules,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Forest Boyce the scheduled rider on the #3, “Sacred Hope,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #1, “Brief Holiday,” #2, “Belongs to Dixie,” #5, “Great Motion,” #6, Kukosa,” and #9, “Work it Out,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #11, “Euro Power,” and #12, “Queenofzeenile,” were scratched as alternates. #3, “Sacred Hope,” was selected for a blood gas test. The distance for this race of about seven and one half furlongs on the turf, was changed to one mile on the main track. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 7 - 10.” Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m. We had two loose horses prior to the start. The #6, “Why Not Be Queen,” unseated rider Andrew Wolfsont who was uninjured. The horse was caught by the outriders, and was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who informed the Stewards that the horse was fit to race. The #7, “My Sister Caro,” unseated rider Brian Pedroza, who was uninjured. The horse was caught by the outriders, and was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano, who informed the Stewards that the horse was fit to race.

INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE - #4 “Summer Sanctuary,” broke down at the ¼ pole unseating its rider, Gilberto Santiago, who was transported to hospital for evaluation. “Summer Sanctuary,” was examined by Dr. Picciano, who diagnosed that the horse sustained a fracture to its left front leg. Subsequently the horse was humanely destroyed. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. #1, “Life Factor,” #2, “Jake Rattle N Roll,” #4, “Drunken Love,” #6, “This Ain’t No Bull,” #7, “Saintly Feelings,” and #11, “Irunalatte,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #10, “Yankee Mickey,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 9 - 3.” Starters - 4**
