Joshua Navarro the scheduled rider on the #7, “Silver Rock,” was changed to Christian Santiago Reyes; no double jocks mount. #6, “Dinny Dinosaur,” stumbled at the start. #6, “Dinny Dinosaur,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 10**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Edwin Gonzalez the scheduled rider on the #4, “Fourleaf Street,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. Joshua Navarro the scheduled rider on the #8, “Idle Spur,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #7, “Givepeaceachance,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Captainofindustry,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**

Joshua Navarro the scheduled rider on the #6, “Gotta Slide,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #7, “Dreamin of Bucks,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, “Don’t Scip a Check,” #12, “Big Dutch,” #13, “Doc Cebu” and #14, “Paris Is Art,” were scratched as alternates. #2, “Razzle Jazil,” was selected for a blood gas test. We experienced a seven-minute delay in the start of this race. The #9, “Sons of Missouri,” was scratched by Dr. Botts for being injured in the starting gate prior to the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:31 p.m. #2, “Siegfried,” pulled up sore after the race at the 7/8 pole. The #2 was examined by Dr. Botts, who said the horse had hit its hock in the starting gate. The horse was removed from the racing surface via the horse ambulance. #3, “Pluracity,” was a vet scratch. #1, “General Ike,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:01 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:02 p.m. Laura Carson the scheduled rider on the #1, “Sey Spottsproof,” was changed to Jose Vega; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6**
