Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Alternate Steward, Ross Pearce, is substituting for Dennis Lima.

We received an appeal from trainer, Juan Vazquez's regarding Stewards ruling 17-2014, concerning his fine and suspension that was issued on June 26, 2014.

We had a delay in start of racing today due to tote problems. The delay was for 10 minutes, first post time was changed to 1:25 p. m. after the delay.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:25 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:26 p.m. #1, "Letsfaceitjohnny," was a vet scratch. #5, "Kingofgoldstreet," was selected for a blood gas test. We had another 13 minute tote delay in making the first race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 7 - 4 - 6."**
Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 2:00 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:00 p.m. #6, "Thunder Brew," was a vet scratch. #3, "August Osage," was selected for a blood gas test. #2, "Winning Touch," was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts. #3, "August Osage," was claimed by Ken Bell – Sandra Matier. #5, "Ok Nothanksforaskin," pulled up sore after the race at the 3/4 pole. The #5 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse had re-bowed. The horse was removed from the racing surface via the horse ambulance. We had another 12 minute tote delay in making the second race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – "7 - 1 - 2 - 3."** **Starters - 6**

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:40 p.m. Yomar Ortiz the scheduled rider on the #8, "Spunky Cat," was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #3, "Princess Marcella," and #9, "Belle of the West," were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, "Carey Princess," was scratched as an alternate. #1, "Sweet Soliloquy," was selected for a blood gas test.

(Third Race Continued) A claim in for #6, “Bonnie Lass,” by Kieron Magee was “VOID” for lack of funds in his horseman’s account. We had a 12 minute delay in the start of this race, as the #1, “Sweet Soliloquy,” flipped in the starting gate. The horse was examined by Dr. Teichner and recommended “Sweet Solioquy” be scratched due to injury. We experienced a 3 minute tote delay in making the third race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 2 - 10.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:10 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:11 p.m. #1, “Brush Creek,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Quality Harbor,” and #3, Longing to Sleep,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. We experienced a 10 minute tote delay in making the fourth race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 5**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:40 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:43 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START – The #2 “Coco Knows,” and #3, “Five Shadwell,” broke through the gate prior to the start. Both the #2, and #3, was declared non-starters for all wagering purposes, due to the #2 and #3 gates opening early. #1, “Coldblack,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. After a two-way shake, #8, “Fond of Candy,” was claimed by Anthracite Stable – Sam Cronk. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 – 1a - 4.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. Daniel Centeno the scheduled rider on the #13, “Determining,” was changed to Jose Caraballo; no double jocks mount. Andrew Wolfsont the scheduled rider on the #14, “Zol Zayne,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #5, “E M Z Firecracker,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #10, “Tobias,” was scratched by its trainer. #11, “Satch,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 14 - 2.” Starters - 11**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. #7, “Our Laughing Lady,” and #8, Thirteen Arrows,” were vet scratches. #6, “Countessa A,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:28 p.m. #2, “Sergeant Pepper MHF,” was selected for a blood gas test. We had a 12 minute delay in the start of this race as the starting gate malfunctioned (the electro-magnets would not hold the doors closed). The Starting gate was replaced with the gate from the Turf course. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 2- 4.” Starters -6**
