Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is performing Graded Stakes testing today for the “ROBERT G. DICK MEMORIAL” and the “DELAWARE OAKS STAKES.”

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #4, “Jive Partner,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 8**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:50 p.m. #1, “Fly’n Bayou,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #13, “Stock Quote,” and #14, “Millennium Lakes,” were scratched as alternates. #8, “Valley Stream,” was selected for a blood gas test. #10, “Target Sighted,” was claimed by The Elkstone Group LLC – Thomas Iannotti. A claim in for the #10, “Target Sighted,” by Home Team Stables & Lillian Hill, was **VOID** as the wrong date was entered on the claim slip. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 11 - 4 - 10.” Starters - 11**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:21 p.m. After a two-way shake, #8, “Gold Diggin Dixie,” was claimed by, Joseph E. Besecker – Jamie Ness. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 8**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m. #5, “Dance Craze,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #6, “Gasparilla Float,” and #7, “Shogun Samurai,” were scratched as main-track only. #10, “Neat Package,” was selected for a blood gas test. #13, “D. Orsay,” stumbled at the start. #9, Edyanne,’ ridden by Carol Cedeno did not finish the race, as her left rein broke coming out of the chute. The #9 was caught and pulled up by the outriders, at the 3/8 pole. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 -10 - 12 - 2.” Starters - 11**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. The #4, “Fairbanks Gold,” with rider Angel Serpa looked like he took a bad step at the 3/8 pole. The rider of the #4 said he thought the #3 Apple Orchard,” ran up from behind clipping his heels. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. #3, “Apple Orchard,” was claimed by Ascendant Farms LLC – Michael Matz. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 8**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF – THE ROBERT G. DICK MEMORIAL STAKES Grade III - POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:54 p.m. #4, “First Romance,” was scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. All horses for this race were blood gas tested. **INQUIRY AT THE 1/8 POLE IN THE STRETCH -** Hold and claim of foul by the #2, “Starstruck (IRE),” Kerwin Clark, against the #10, Aigue Marine (GB),” Kendrick Carmouche, and the #11, “Topic,” Jose Caraballo, for interfering with him at the 1/8 pole in the stretch. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the #11 came out in front of the #2 causing him to clip heels. We disqualified the #11 from second and placed him 9th behind the #2 who was moved up to 8th for interference at the 1/8 pole in the stretch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 5 - 12 - 8.” Starters - 12**

SEVENTH RACE – THE CARL HANFORD MEMORIAL STAKES - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m. Angel Castillo, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Indian Jones,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Spa City Fever,” #4 “Koh I Noor,” and #7, “Cerro (IRE),” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #6, “Service for Ten,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 6**

EIGHTH RACE – THE OH SAY STAKES - POST TIME – 4:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m. #2, “Classic Giacnroll,” and #8, “Rockinn On Bye,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #5, “Debt Ceiling,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “It’s a Bang,” ridden by Daniel Centeno, was eased at the 3/8th pole. The #7 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who said he could see anything wrong with the horse. The horse walked off the racing surface under its own power. Daniel Cento the jockey of the #7 said the horse was travelling off so he pulled him up. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 9 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS – THE BUZZ BRAUNINGER ARABIAN DISTAFF HANDICAP Grade I - POST TIME – 6:01 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:01 p.m. #1, “Alphaa,” was scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #1a, “RB Burn Baby Burn,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7**
