Wayne regarding information that he received regarding a fight between jockeys that occurred on Saturday, July 5, 2014 following the 5th race. Mr. Wayne advised that the information he received indicated that jockeys ANGEL SERPA and TREVOR McCARTHY were involved. Mr. Wayne directed us to have Inspectors Delaney and Swift investigate the allegations and report on their findings. Details of this matter will be reported under DTRC case file DT 8-123.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #7, “Dream of Pegasus,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Epic Story,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Princess Marcela,” pulled up sore after the race at the 6-1/2 furlong marker. The #5 was examined by Dr. John Peters, who reported that the horse was sore. Subsequently, “Princess Marcela” was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance.

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. J.D. Acosta, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Ellipse,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. Pierre Hernandez Ortega, the scheduled rider on the #10, “Part One,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #9, “New Yawker,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Tuxedo Ray,” #3, “Shimmy Tinjo,” and #11, “Atomic Orange Vet,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “Sky Above,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Good Feng Shui,” was claimed by Top Notch Racing - Michael Pino. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 8 - 4.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. #4, “BR Dance in Red,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Love To Dance,” ducked out at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 7**
