Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### **Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Wednesday, June 25, 2014 concerning Sample #44640 which was on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, has been cleared.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Thursday, June 26, 2014 were all clear, with the following exception: Sample #44645 which is on hold, awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Saturday, June 28, 2014 were all clear, with the following exception: Sample #44664 which is on hold, awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Monday, June 30, 2014 were all clear, with the following exceptions: Samples #44670 and #44671 are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-examination workout test result from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Friday, June 27, 2014, sample #44754 failed, due to having excessive “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 2.7 micrograms per milliliter of plasma.
- Post-examination workout test result from L.G.C. Lexington Sports Science for Monday, June 30, 2014, sample #44641 was clear.

### **Administrative:**

All three Stewards attended the post-position draw for the “DELAWARE HANDICAP.”

A Trainers exam was administered on Tuesday, July 8, 2014 to Owner, Lucia Garivay. Ms. Garivay has passed the written examination, and will be issued a certificate of completion.

An Assistant Trainers exam was administered on Tuesday, July 8, 2014 to exercise rider, Joanne Robinson to be an assistant for trainer Niles Saville. Ms. Robinson has passed the written examination, and will be issued a certificate of completion.

Trainer Juan Vazquez contacted the Stewards and he opted to have the split sample sent to a referee laboratory. Subsequently, the split sample was sent to the Pennsylvania Equine Toxicology & Research Center to confirm the presence of “Stanozolol” which was previously discovered in the post-race sample #40459 from the horse “A. P. Wild” who finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the 2<sup>nd</sup> race on May 21, 2014.

We held films on Monday, July 7, 2014. Jockey Jose Caraballo who rode the horse “Topic,” in the 6<sup>th</sup> race on Saturday July 5, 2014 had been disqualified from 2<sup>nd</sup>, and placed 9<sup>th</sup> for interference in the stretch. The Stewards ruled that Jockey Caraballo be suspended 7 calendar days for his actions. Following the issuance of the ruling, Jockey Caraballo filed an appeal with the Commission contesting the suspension.

Two Jockeys and their Valets were selected today for random drug testing. All tests were negative for controlled substances.

After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #6 broke outward with the #8 breaking straight, and the #7 breaking slowly. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 8**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7**

Besecker – Scott Lake. **ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 4 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 11**
