Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test results from LGC, the official Laboratory for the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission returned a certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #40488. The certificate of analysis reported that sample #40488 taken from “Another Surprise,” who ran in the second race on Wednesday, May 28, 2014, contained “Methocarbamol.” The trainer of this horse, Jonathan Sheppard was informed telephonically by the Stewards. Subsequently, trainer Sheppard informed the Stewards, that he would exercise his right to a split sample.
- Trainer Sheppard was also informed that the official laboratory returned a positive finding and certificate of analysis on his horse, “Comancheria,” sample # 44547 which also contained “Methocarbamol.” “Comancheria” ran in the second race on June 9, 2014. Trainer Sheppard also opted to have the split sample confirmed by a referee laboratory.
- Post-race test results from LGC returned a certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44502. The certificate of analysis reports that sample #44502 for the horse “Hiram,” from the second race on Thursday, June 5, 2014, contained “Methocarbamol.” D. Scott Peck, the trainer of “Hiram” was informed of this matter by a DTRC Inspector who conducted a barn inspection regarding the positive test. Subsequently, trainer Peck appeared before the Stewards, stating that he would exercise his right to a split sample.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:15 p.m.** #4, “Etar,” and #7, “Mine N Gems,” were vet scratches. #1a, “One Roll,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1a, “One Roll,” was claimed by Razor Blade Racing LLC – A. Ferris Allen III. #5, “Newton Crescent,” was claimed by Jorge Diaz – Ruben Monjes. #6, “Mister Dish,” was claimed by Spur Run Farm – Alejandro Reyes. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race, as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 – 1a.” Starters – 6**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by Alex Cintron the rider of the #2, “Fudge E,” against Victor Carrasco the rider of the #8, “Ifyougotthenotion,” for coming out and intimidating his horse. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #8 came out in the stretch intimidating and carrying the #2 wide through the stretch. The Stewards disqualified the #8 from first and placed him second behind the #2 who was moved up to first. #7, “Hope in Your Rope,” #11, “Corporate Measure,” and #12, “Run to the Limit,” were scratched as main-track only. #4, “How Cool Is He,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m.** #4, “Deployingresources,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Cusabo,” was claimed by John Fanelli & Exacta B.S. LLC – Juan Vazquez. After a two-way shake, #7, “Senor Quickie,” was claimed by Annette Eubanks – Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 7**

The owner and trainer that claimed the #4, “Miss Dayna Lee,” requested a \$140.00 dollar all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 – 1a - 8 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m.** #5, “Speightslegacy,” and #6, “Forgetthefantasy,” were vet scratches. After a two-way shake, #4, “Breezy Girl,” was claimed by, Richard Sillaman - Owner Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 – 1 & 8 DH – 9 - 3.” Starters - 7**
