Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Monday, June 30, 2014 concerning Sample #44671 which was previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, has been cleared.
- A post-race test from L.G.C. Science for Saturday, July 5, 2014 concerning sample #44782, has been cleared.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Monday, July 7, 2014, have all been cleared.

Administrative:

We held a hearing for stable employees, Manuel and Carolyn Huerta, for having a firearm on the licensee's grounds, without written permission. After hearing the testimony presented, the Stewards decided to fine Manuel and Carolyn Huerta \$500.00 each for the violation. *(It is noted that both subjects had been previously ejected from the grounds under management prerogative. Their exclusion is still in force.)*

We held films on Monday, July 14, 2014. Jockey Alex Cintron who rode the horse "Pico's Pride," in the 6th race on Saturday July 12, 2014 had been disqualified from 1st, and placed 7th for interference after the start. The Stewards ruled that Jockey Cintron be suspended 7 calendar days for his actions.

We held films on Wednesday, July 16, 2014. Jockey Victor Carrasco rode the horse "Ifyougotthenotion," in the 4th race on Monday July 14, 2014 and had been disqualified from 1st, and placed 2nd for interference in the stretch. The Stewards ruled that Jockey Carrasco be suspended 7 calendar days for his actions.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Miss Andorra,” was scratched for track conditions. #3, “Hey Parker,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #3, “Hey Parker,” broke out the first jump out of the gate, causing a chain reaction that involved the #4 #5 and #6, with the #3 finishing last. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, making the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #1, “Indiana Moon,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Key to a Cure,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake #2, “Secret Jackpot,” was claimed by, Happy Hour Stables LLC – Paul McClelland. #6, “Key to a cure,” was claimed by W.E.S. Stable – Denise Cotrone. #7, “Magic Lion,” was claimed by Kieron Magee – Owner-Trainer. The #1a, “Good Chemistry,” had to be sent back to the paddock, to change the saddle cloth the #1 had been placed on the 1a by mistake. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 6 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. Alberto Delgado, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Mo Bagels,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #4, “Mide as Well,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 6**

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #8, “Winding Road,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Tap’n My Toes,” and #10, “Lonely Whistle,” were vet scratches. #4, “Wandering Kitten,” #7, “Amber Coast, #11, “East of Danzig” and #14, “Fire Ruler,” were scratched due to this race being taken off the turf. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 12 - 13 - 9.” Starters - 8**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. Alberto Delgado, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Change in Control,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #4, “Gronk,” and #7, “It’s a Plane,” were vet scratches. #8, “Running on Wishes,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 2 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #3, “Kelly’s Endeavour,” and #13, “Golden Bucket,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #5, “Found,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Love This Kitty,” #7, “Avie,” and #14, “Smart N Smokin,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. The #1, “Bogelia,” started bucking shortly after breaking from the gate and was eased to the finish. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 11 - 2.” Starters - 8**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. #2, “Debit Card,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**
