Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test from L.G.C. Science for Wednesday, May 28, 2014 concerning sample #40495 which was previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, has been cleared.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. . #2, “Sarasota Empress,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE –** Claim of foul by Carlos Luis Gutierrez the rider of #4 “Gold On Gold,” against Brian Pedroza, the rider of the #5, “Overlook,” for coming in at the three-eighths pole taking his room away. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #5 was turned in when the #4 bumped him from the inside. Due to the #4 causing the problem, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action, and made the race official. It was noted that Jockey Gutierrez the rider of #4 “Gold On Gold,” hit the #5, “Overlook,” intentionally with his whip at the three-eighths pole. #3, “Unsighted,” was claimed by Robert Gamber,” Wayne Potts. A claim in for the #3, “Unsighted,” by Juan Arriagada – Rodolfo Romero was VOID as the name of the horse was spelled incorrectly **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 2.”** **Starters – 6** (*Jockey Gutierrez’s actions will be discussed by the Stewards with him at the next session of film reviews in the Jockey’s Room*).

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1, “Deb’s Trip,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Baby Butterscotch,” was claimed by Andres Garibay – Lucia Garibay. #1a, “Exhilarate,” stumbled at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 - 6.”** **Starters - 7**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #5, “Carolina Princess,” was claimed by Kieron Magee – Owner Trainer. #1, “Miz Marzy,” broke down and was pulled up at the seven and a half furlong marker by its rider, Trevor McCarthy. “Miz Marzy” was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters and diagnosed that the horse suffered a broken front left leg. The horse was subsequently humanely destroyed.

THIRD RACE (Continued) Jockey McCarthy was uninjured as he had dismounted the ill-fated animal and held it while awaiting arrival of the outrider. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #8, “Asalor,” was selected for a blood gas test. Abel Castellano Jr., the scheduled rider on the #12, “Kildare,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #5, “Road Boss,” was scratched as a main-track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 11**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #6, “Fulton Street,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Isolation Road,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Bowman’s Boy,” was claimed by Raul Arriagada – Rodolfo Romero. After a two-way shake, #3, “Sportswriter,” was claimed by Andres Garibay – Lucia Garibay. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. #11, “Roses and Dreams,” was scratched as a main-track only. #3, “Tippie Tap,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Tippie Tap,” was claimed by McLean Robinson – Owner-Trainer. The Owner-Trainer that claimed “Tippie Tap,” requested a steroids only special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 11**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. #8, “Lucky Lady Lawyer,” and #9, “Wunderbar,” were vet scratches. #2, “Winter Lady,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 7**

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. Gregorio Rivera, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Dahmas Mischief MHF,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 6**
