Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Thursday, July 10, 2014 were all clear with the exception of samples #44817, #44814 and #44819 which are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Saturday, July 12, 2014 were all clear with the following exceptions: Samples #44839, #44837 and #44841 are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Monday, July 14, 2014 were all clear except sample #44846, which is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m. #1, “Full of Intent,” and #4, “Michelle’s Trip,” were vet scratches. #5, “With Class,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Our Silver Crown,” stumbled at the start. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 4

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #11, “Two Times a Nite,” was scratched by its trainer. #5, “Harlington Romance,” and #7, “Fair Harbor,” were scratched as main-track only. #2, “Bold Miss,” was selected for a blood gas test. The placing judges posted 3-6-1-4 as the order of finish on the tote board, without posting a photo sign for place and show. The order of finish was then changed to 3-6-4-1 on the board by the placing judges, without a photo sign being posted. The correct order of finish, by the official photo was 3-6-4-1 which was confirmed and made official by the Stewards. We had a discussion with the Placing Judges regarding the matter.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. INQUIRY JUST PAST THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE – Hold and claim of foul by Carol Cedeno the rider of #5 “Grand Mast,” against Angel Castillo, the rider of the #6, “Baby Face Aiden,” for coming in just past the three-eighths pole, taking her room away and causing her horse to clip heels. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #6 came in causing the #5 to clip heels. The #6 was disqualified from 2nd and placed 4th behind the #5 who was moved up to 3rd. #2, “Cheops,” and #3, “Jazz Age,” were vet scratches. A claim in for the #4, “Concorde’s Peace,” by Mark Valentine – Anthony Pecoraro, was “Void” as the wrong race was entered on the claim blank. #6, “Baby Face Aiden,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 5

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m. #8, “Sparkling Jewel,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #10, “Distiller,” #11, “Market Blaster,” and #12, “Livonzin,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Hertzalot,” was claimed by R. J. McGee – Marilyn McMullen.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 5 - 9.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m. #1, “Soft Ball,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Nicki Flash,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. A claim in for the #1a, “Bumpy Ride,” by Southview Stable – Michael Pino, was “Void” as they lacked sufficient funds in their horsemen’s account. #8, “Terry Blossom,” stumbled at the start. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m. #1, “Memphis Sunrise,” was scratched by its trainer. #5, “Tiz Showbiz,” and #13, “The Third Ace,” were scratched as main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 12 - 11 - 7.” Starters - 11

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START – The #4, “Warrioroftheroses,” charged the gate prior to the start, breaking slowly. #1a, “Candyman E,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Mystical Terp,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Sloane Ranger,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 5**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. #5, “Chispi Affair,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7**
