Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Saturday, July 5, 2014 concerning samples #44771 and #44771 which were previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, have been cleared.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Wednesday, July 16, 2014 were all clear except sample #44870, which is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “All D’ Night,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1, “C V Outlaw,” and #3, “Espiritu Libre,” were vet scratches. #8, “Livonzin,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Silent Tale,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #2, “Silent Tale,” broke a step slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 9 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #3, “Quarterback Sneak,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #1, “Rock Slide Johnny,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Mtsthelensspirit,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Strait Smile,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1a, “Captainofindustry,” was claimed by Worchester Investments LLC – Wayne Potts.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 1a - 2 - 6.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. #7, “Steel Curtain,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Evil Lad,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #3, “Vindicated,” was claimed by Triple R Stable – Rodolfo Romero.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:55 p.m. Kerwin Clark, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Five Star Prince,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe, no double jocks mount. #2, “Hurler,” and #5, “Flying Forward,” were scratched as main-track only. #11, “Count On Buddy,” was scratched by the stewards. #10, “Sky Above,” was claimed by Lacy Kay Williams – Owner Trainer. The #3, “One Sock Down,” was scratched at two minutes to post by the Stewards upon recommendation of Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who said the horse was bleeding profusely from the mouth. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN** – Hold and claim of foul by Horacio Karamanos the rider of #9 “Peppermint Prince,” against Brian Pedroza the rider of the #7, “Yankee Mickey,” for coming out down the stretch, bumping his horse and knocking him off stride. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #7 came out bumping the #9. The #7 was disqualified from 3rd and placed 5th behind the #9 who was moved up to 4th. *(It was learned later by the Stewards that “One Sock Down” had sustained a cut to its tongue)*

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 12 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. #5, “Mr. Rover,” was a vet scratch. The #6, “Distiller,” was eased past the finish; the rider Eric Camacho said the horse was off in the right front so he pulled him up.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. Juan Torres, the scheduled rider on the #1, “RB Rich Kin,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 2 – 1a.” Starters - 8
