Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Thursday, July 17, 2014 were all clear except sample #44900, which is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Saturday, July 19, 2014 were all clear.
- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Monday, July 21, 2014 were all clear except sample #44922, which is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- LGC Science reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44670, taken from the horse “Reid the News” which ran in the 7<sup>th</sup> race on Monday, June 30, 2014, contained a combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of record, Arturo Rodriguez, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspectors Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Rodriguez’s assigned barn area. Results of the inspection revealed phenylbutazone tablets. Hearing pending.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “Lake Michigan,”**  
was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #4, “Four Star Princess,”**  
was a vet scratch. #3, “Ghazi’s Stone,” was claimed by Andrew Simoff – Owner Trainer.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.** #1, “Fourleaf Street,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Faithful Servant,” #5, “Bold and Ready,” and #8, “Bold Harmony,” were trainer scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show, wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN** – Hold and claim of foul by Jose Vega the rider of #7 “Coldblack,” Luis Garcia the rider of the #6, “My Boy Jimmy,” Fray Martinez the rider of the #4, “Rift,” and trainer of the #7, Juan Vazquez, claimed foul against jockey Martin Solis aboard the #2, “Tinder Lord,” for coming out down the stretch, bumping and impeding their horses. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #2 came out bumping the #7, causing the #7 to bump the #6, which forced the #4 out. The #2 was disqualified from 1st and placed 4th behind the #7, #6, and #4, who were placed in front of the #2, for interference against all three horses in the stretch.

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** Luis Batista, the scheduled rider on the #6, “So Serene,” was changed to Luis Garcia; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Hailey’s Star,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Age of Aquarius,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Freshcat,” #7, “Take the Train,” #8, “Stollen,” and #12, “Pennies Appeal,” were scratched by their trainers. #6, “So Serene,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 11 - 6 - 9.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.** 5, “Love Undercover,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Clowns to the Left,” was claimed by Four Treasures Farm LLC – Annette Eubanks.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 10**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m. ON THE TURF –** Carol Cedenno, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Scarlet Cimarron,” was changed to Jose Flores; no double jocks mount. Alberto Delgado, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Northern Smile,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #1, “Means Well,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Hobe Wins,” was scratched as a main-track only.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1a - 8.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.** Angel Serpa, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Our Carly,” was changed to Carol Cedenno; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Calamity Kate,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Looking for Lucky,” was scratched by its trainer. #12, “Pagan Joy,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Manille,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 9 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 10**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m. #2,** “RB Code,” was selected for a blood gas test. Gregorio Rivera the rider of the #3, “DR Burn,” was easing the horse before the finish line, just getting beat for second place. Mr. Rivera was requested to be in the Stewards office tomorrow, to explain why he eased the horse just before the finish. Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters was requested to examine the horse “DR Burn,” to see if a physical condition was evident, that would have required the rider to start easing the horse. After talking to jockey Rivera he stated that the last sixteenth of a mile the horse was not breathing and he was worried about the horse collapsing. Dr. Peters reported to us that the horse had a severe case of “Thumps” which was confirmed and treated by private practitioner, Dr. Liam Clerkin. “Thumps can be a severe breathing disorder in a thoroughbred race horse,” Dr. Clerkin advised.
