Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

- Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science for Wednesday, July 23, 2014 were all clear except samples #44931 and #44937, which are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Sample #40480 from May 26, 2014 which was previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis was cleared.
- Sample #44548 from June 9, 2014 which was previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, has been cleared.
- Post-race test results from LGC Science, reported on their certificate of analysis for sample #44613, taken from the horse “Atomic Orange Vet,” which ran in the 7th race on Thursday, June 19, 2014, contained the combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of record, Shellaine Brown was informed of the laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspectors Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of trainer Brown’s, assigned barn area. Results of the inspection revealed only electrolytes.
- A certificate of analysis from LGC Science regarding sample #44670 which was taken from “Ok Nothanksforaskin” which ran in the 2nd race on June 19, 2014 was positive for a combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of this horse, Pedro Rodriguez, was informed of this laboratory finding telephonically by the Stewards.

#4, “Doctor S,” #5, “Irunalatte,” #6, “Unlocked,” and #7, “Public Secret,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #9, “Cee ‘n O,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 5

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m.

#2, “Icon Ike,” #5, “Tate’s Landing,” #6, “This Ain’t No Bull,” and #7, “Private Tutor,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #4, “Won the War,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 4

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #1a, “Brahms

Bracelet,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Fran’s Image,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Raising Passion,” was claimed by Lacey K. Williams – Owner Trainer.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME 3:49 p.m.. – OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m

The distance for this race was changed from seven and one half furlongs on the turf, to one-mile on the main track. #1, “Sam’s Sonic,” #2, “It’s Time to Reign,” and #5, “Loren’s Rock,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #12, “Kearney Square,” #13, “Spiral Stair,” and #14, “Curlin’s Kid,” were scratched as alternates.

INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START – The #6, “Big Zapple,” with rider Brian Pedroza broke a step slowly, clipping heels with the #7, “I Will,” ridden by Javier Santiago, shortly after the start. Jockey Pedroza was unseated by this exchange. The #8, “Crossing,” came in shortly after the start, intimidating the #7, causing the #7 to go in, and the #3, beaking out at the start, forcing the #4 out, who could not relieve any pressure on the #6. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, and made the race official. The rider of the #6 Brian Pedroza was taken to hospital for evaluation.

ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 9 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. Cecily Evans, the

scheduled rider on the #1, “How Cool Is He,” was changed to Mohamed Osman; no double jocks mount. #4, “Tarifa,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Mr. Fahrenheit,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 5

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m. #4,

“Alphaa,” was selected for a blood gas test.
