## ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

We held a hearing on Tuesday, August 5, 2014 concerning sample #44502 taken from the horse, "Hiram," who was the winner of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Race on June 5, 2014. The official laboratory reported that the sample in question was positive for "Methocarbamol." The trainer of record, D. Scott Peck opted to have the split sample sent to referee laboratory, the University of California at Davis (UC Davis - Maddy Lab). UC Davis confirmed the presence of "Methocarbamol" in the split sample. Based on the evidence presented in this matter, the Stewards ruled that trainer Peck be fined the sum of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Furthermore, "HIRAM" was disqualified from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Race and purse monies be redistributed. Ruling to be filed.
